Monday Sept the 5	Commerce with strong breeze from the S.W. and fairing clouds with a heavy swell bearing from the S.W. toward the S.E. all evening and out to the West. Monday ship in weather in Can to end. Lat by Oh 32:56
Tuesday Sept the 6	Commerce with moderate breeze from S.W. and pleasant at 1 PM. Saw the land shining. E. 30 miles. Set at sunset 15 miles. Set back of the S.W. from the north with faint strong winds and heavy latter part pleasant headed in from the Bay of Hudding at 11 AM. Came to anchor in five fathoms to end this day.
Wednesday Sept the 7	All those 24 miles moderate breeze and calm sailing to Ancon implying in fainting sleep to end this day.
Thursday Sept the 8	Commerce with moderate breeze from the S.W. and pleasant. Lay at Ancon and boats came on shore to end this day.
Friday Sept the 9	All those 24 miles moderate breeze from S.W. and calm long to Ancon and boats came on shore to end this day.
Saturday Sept the 10	Commerce with moderate breeze from the S.W. and pleasant. Latter part strong breeze from the S.W. and cloudy. Lay at Ancon and boats came on shore to end this day.
Sunday Sept the 11	Commerce with strong winds from the S.W. and fairing. Latter part winds from the S.W. and pleasant and boats came on shore and liberty to end this day.

on D. Whaling being the 6th of Sept

Monday Sept the 12	All those 24 miles heavy breeze from the S.W. and fairing clouds. Lay at Ancon and boats came on shore to end this day.
Tuesday Sept the 13	All those 24 miles strong winds from the S.W. and pleasant. Lay at Ancon and boats came on shore to end this day.
Wednesday Sept the 14	All those 24 miles Lay at Ancon. Winds from the S.W. and pleasant and boats came on shore to end this day.
Thursday Sept the 15	first and middle part lay at Ancon. Winds from the S.W. and pleasant. Lay at Ancon and boats came on shore to end this day.
Friday Sept the 16	Commerce with moderate breeze from the S.W. and pleasant at sunset the S.W. point of Whalerah Bay. Came to 10 miles. Set middle part headed to the W. S.W. Latter part W. S.W. from the W. S.W. headed to the S.W. and in the S.W. to end this day.
Saturday Sept the 17	Commerce with strong winds from the S.W. and frequent squalls of rain at a 10 mile double near the top of at 5 miles in the fore and Ancon. Topped and close near the main and have his ten middle and latter part again of wind from the S.W. headed to the W. under storm sails to end. Lat by Oh 32:44
Sunday Sept the 18	first and middle part a part of wind from the S.W. and fairing clouds headed to the W. under storm sails. Latter part in moderate set double near top of sails to end. Lat by Oh 33:04 Lay by Ancon 12:54
