

Journal of Bark Island Oct 18

- Friday Oct the 16 All there 24 acres moderate breezes from the NW and pleasant headed to the S. Saw a number of finches to birds Lat by 36 45
- Saturday Oct the 17 Breeze with little sea from the S and S.W. headed to the S. Saw a number of finches, middle and latter part strong breezes from the S. Headed to the S. Lat by 36 45
- Sunday Oct the 18 Breeze with strong breezes from the S and S.W. headed to the S. Latter part day to headed to the E. Latter part strong breeze from the S. Headed to the S. Lat by 38 14
- Monday Oct the 19 Breeze with strong winds from the NW and passing clouds headed to the S. Under short sail middle part winds headed to the NW and may second ship to the NW & back in the passage. Latter part winds headed to the NW and saw an evening heavy gale day to under a gross wind more topsails and staysails down as observed
- Tuesday Oct the 20 Breeze with a heavy gale of wind from the NW and heavy rain day to headed to the W. Under staysails and topsails middle part the gale abated latter part the winds headed to the NW but the passage and double reef mainsails headed to the W and E. Lat by 37 51

Whaling voyage to the Atlantic 1840

- Wednesday Oct the 21 Breeze with a heavy gale of wind from the NW and heavy rain headed to the NW & under staysails at 8 PM the ship headed to the NW latter part more moderate do ends Lat by 34 30
- Thursday Oct the 22 first and middle part strong wind from NW and heavy rain headed to the NW under staysails latter part more moderate wind ship to the S. Lat by 37 30
- Friday Oct the 23 All there 24 acres strong breezes from the NW and S.W. headed by 6 PM to the NW under short sail do ends this day Lat by 37 40
- Saturday Oct the 24 All there 24 acres moderate breezes from the NW and passing clouds headed an opposite look saw several note whales sound several time but not seen boats Lat by 38 00
- Sunday Oct the 25 Breeze with brisk winds from the W headed to the NW saw a number of note whales sound but could not find at the next observed sea middle and latter part strong winds from the W day to headed to the E. Lat by 38 00
- Monday Oct the 26 first and middle part a gale of wind from the W and heavy rain headed to the E. Under staysails latter part winds shifting to the NW and passed away double reef staysails headed to the NW at 8 PM saw three whales going quick to the W. Headed to the NW Lat by 38 16
