Monday Nov 23

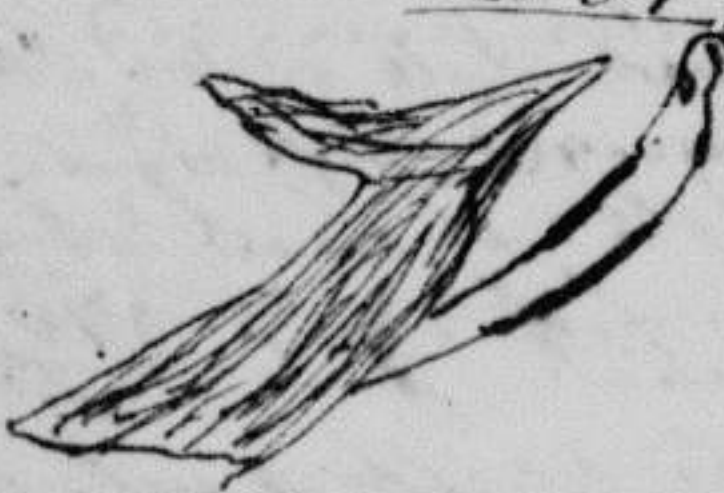
All there 24 hours a gale of wind from the W and frequent squalls of rain headed to the W & under close reef saw nothing towards the S

Sun by Chron 20.09



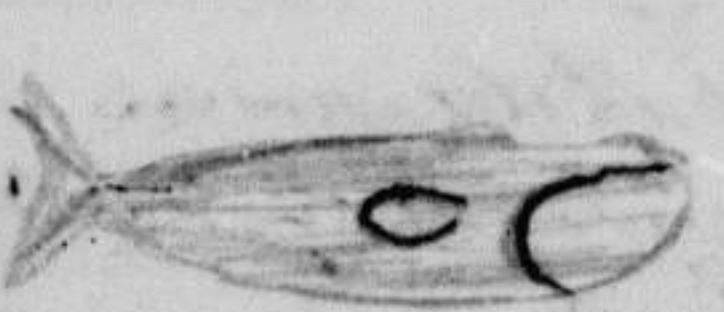

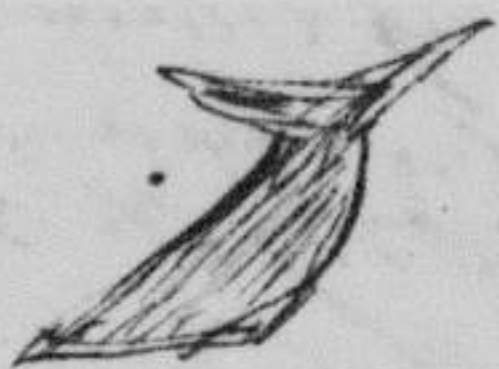
Friday Nov 27

Sun by Chron 20.08

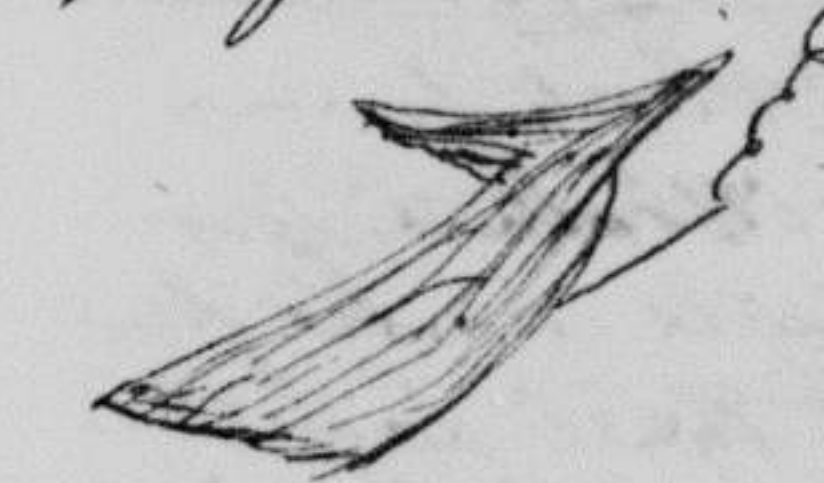

All there 24 hours moderate breezes from S to W and pleasant in Bayling at 8 PM land and forced to S & W and called him and he sunk to under the ship Lat by 20 36 22

Tuesday Dec 1



Commerce with moderate breezes from the N & W and strong clouds headed and tactics saw a number of whales land and forced to one the inner middle and latter point at sunset first Bayling in the latter point strong winds from the N & W under close reef land and forced to S & W under strong breezes and S & W in latter point Lat by 20 36 46
