Remarks on board Monday March 5th 1838

First part fine breeze at S.E. and pleasant stered at 10th M. saw black-fish put off but did not strike at 2nd came on board. Latter part squally and rainy with lightning at 1st P.M. took in the gaff top-sail top-gallant sails and flying jib at 6th set the gaff top-sail and top-gallant sails at 7th stered at 10th M.

Remarks on board Tuesday March 6th 1838

First part moderate trades at S.E. and cloudy stered at 10th M. Latter part the same
Lat by Obs 4.44 South

Remarks on board Wednesday March 7th 1838

First part fresh trades at S.E. and squally stered at 10th M. Latter part moderate trades from S.E. to S.W. with lightning. set the flying jib and gaff top-sail. Latter part a light breeze at S.E. and cloudy
Lat by Obs 4.18 South

Remarks on board Thursday March 8th 1838

First part a moderate breeze from S.W. and cloudy stered at 10th M. under all sail. Latter part a fresh gale at S.W. and cloudy at 1st P.M. took in the flying jib. Latter part a fresh gale at S.W. and pleasant at 1st P.M. set the flying jib at 11th took it in
