

Journal of a Whaling voyage in the Atlantic

Remarks on board Monday July 30th 38
First part a Gale from S West trying
to Southward at 8 took in the Fore Slop
sail at 8 A.M. parted the Mizzen Stays sent
it on Deck to repair & so end saw a School of
Blackfish Lat 40 43 Long by Abs 34 30 W

Remarks Tuesday July 31st
A Gale from W S W trying to Southward
under Main Topsail & Fore sail at 4 finished
the Mizzen Stays and set it up same in Brig
and Ship mends Lat 40 09 Long by ac 30 30 W

Remarks Wednesday August 1st
First and Middle parts a Gale from S W
and Squally trying to Southward under
Main Topsail and Foresail the latter part Fresh
Gales set all sail sent the Mizzen Staysail
seeds Lat 39 26 Long by Abs 28 50

Remarks Thursday August 2^d
Fresh Gales from W S W & Squally steering
South 2 Sails in sight at 10 tacked Ship
at 4 A.M. tacked Ship at 6 made Bayall
bearing S S E Dist 12 miles at 8 tacked
Ship so end Bayall bearing S E by S Dist 20 miles

Remarks Friday August 3^d
Fresh Gales from W S W steering
N W 1 sail in sight at 1 A.M. tacked
Ship so end Bayall bearing East Dist
saw several shoals of porpoises 25

Remarks Saturday August 4th
Light Gales from W S W & pleasant
steering Southward saw 4 Sails at 10 the
Fore sail part minding the latter part beating
up to Bayall so end Bayall the Town of
Atto bearing N by W Dist 3 miles

Remarks on board Barque George Washington Capt. J. H. Lewis

Remarks on board Sunday August 5th 1838
First part light Breeze from N W at 1
Capt. Whiteus went on shore at Atto at 7
returned with potatoes & vegetables at 8 A.M.
of the crew went on shore on liberty

Remarks Monday August 6th
Light Breeze from Westward trying off and
on at 7 the men come on board at 8 A.M.
the remainder of the crew went on shore to
refresh themselves 4 sails in sight

Remarks Tuesday August 7th
Light Breeze from Westward and pleasant
trying of 5 on at 1 sent a raft of cables on
shore for water while there Aaron Perkins
left the Boat and has not been seen since
at 7 the liberty men come on board all but one
George Henry the latter part calm with the
current and swell having us on towards Bayall
at 9 hooked on two Boats to tow the Ship of shore
at 10 light air from the S East Boats come along
side 10 A.M. Capt. Whiteus went on shore at Atto
so end 4 ships company trying off and on

Remarks Wednesday August 8th
Fresh Breeze from Westward South West
and pleasant trying of and on at 5 that the
water along side & hoisted in all but 4 cable
which broke away from along side sent 2
boats to take them in tow but the current sweep
to the Land to strong to get them up to the
Ship at 10 A.M. sent these cables on board
and hoisted them in so end 4 sails in company
this day shipped 3 Potatoes the above men have not been found
