Remarks on board Monday Oct 8th 1838

First and middle parts a Gale from
N W trying to N E toward the
latter part Fresh Breeze from West
Course North set the Fore Topsail.
Fore sail Gilt Spanker and turns
one reef out each Topsail broke out
the main hold for water and the
after hold for butter Mackerel and
Soap so ends saw Hinbuck's
Lat 35.41 South
Long by Chron 21 28 West

Remarks Tuesday Oct 9th 1838

Fresh Breeze from N West and
pleasant Course North employed
repairing the Foresail saw a Ship
of the Sea Bore at 6 took in sail
at 8 A M set all sail at 9 spoke
the Washington of James Port Capt
Wilber with 15000 sperm Oil Capt
Whitens went on board at the latter
part 2 sails in sight so ends Course
N W Lat 34 51 South
Long by Chron 21 West

Remarks Wednesday Oct 10th

Fresh Breeze from S S W and
pleasant steering by the wind to Westward
at 1/2 past mer the Washington saw
Bright Whales lowered the Boats got near
at 3 spoke the Concorda of Copenhagen
Capt The Seeger went on
board at 5k saw a Sperm Whale
all three Ships lowered the Boats
at 4 past 5 Boats came on board and
took in sail at 6 et all made all sail
at 8 took Ship to Eastward wind
S S East at 11k saw Hinbuck's at Merid
tacked Ship to Southward name S S East
3 sails in sight Lat 34 27 South
Long by Chron 22 33 West

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Cruising for Right Whales

Remarks on board Thursday Oct 11th 1838

First part light Breeze from S S East
and pleasant steering by the wind to
Southward 3 Sails in sight employed
* repairing the Foresail at 6k took in sail
the latter part Fresh Breeze from S S E more
all sail employed repairing the Foresail
at ship in sight at 11 saw 2 sperm
Whales lowered the Boats in company
with another Ship so ends

Remarks Friday Oct 12th

First part Fresh Gale from N E
and pleasant 1/2 past Meridian Boats
* some on board got nothing started
different courses at 4k saw a shoal
of sperm Whales at 7 took in sail
15 Ships in sight the latter a Gale from
N E East at 6 et all set the Fore
Topsail and Gilt at 7k took in the
Gilt at 10 took in the Fore Topsail
employed repairing the Foresail one sail
in sight so ends Lat 34 40 South
Long by Chron 22 42 West

Remarks on board Sat Oct 13th

A Gale from Northward and raining
trying to Eastward at 4 took in the
Foresail employed repairing the Foresail

Remarks Sunday Oct 14th

First part a Gale from Northward
trying to Eastward under main chain Topsail
Mizzen Staytail and Fore Spanker the
latter part calm with light Breeze and
raining one sail in sight so ends
Lat 35 15 South
Long by Chron 21 59 West
