First part Fresh Breezes from Westward
steering different courses set the fore
topsail at 6 took it in one
sail in sight the latter part employed
making a storm Chizen

Remarks Friday Nov 2^d
Fresh Gale from Eastward steering
different courses employed making
a storm Chizen at 5 took in
sail at 6 at 11 made sail
Lat 35.31 Long by Chron 17.59

Remarks Saturday Nov 3^d
Fresh Gale from the West and blowing
steering by the wind to NW under
the Spanker and bent the Mizzen at
6 took in sail saw birds back the
latter part made all sail back
out the after hold for provisions
Lat 34.31 South Long by Chron 20.21 W

Remarks Sunday Nov 4th
Light Breezes from Westward and
pleasant steering by the Wind to
Northward at 12 part Mer saw 2
Right Whales lowered the Boats
at 4 came on board got nothing
at 6 took in sail at 9 wore ship
Wind NW the latter part Cours
W by N saw birds back
Lat South Long West

Remarks Monday Nov 5th
First part Fresh Gales from N by East
and cloudy steering to Westward saw
birds back at 6 took in sail the latter
part a Gale from Northward and
raining took in the foresail as

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 6th 1838

First part a Gale from Northward
and raining with a very heavy squall
at 4 bent the fore Staysail and bent
another at 4 took in the Main Topsail
at 5 the Mast Boat washed of the crane
and went over board took her in one deck
stone at 7 set the Main Topsail Wind
WNW the latter part employed repairing
and fitting a Boat for the mast
Boat

Remarks Wednesday Nov 7th
A Gale from NW West and raining
trying to CB W the latter part wind
from SW wore ship and set the
foresail Lat 35.33 Long by Chron 21.08 W

Remarks Thursday Nov 8th
First part a Gale from Southward trying
to Westward the middle and latter part
Fresh Breezes made all sail

Remarks Friday Nov 9th
First part Fresh Breezes from Eastward
steering to Westward at 6 took in sail
the latter part Fresh Breezes from Eastward
lowered the Mast 4 sails out for water
Lat 34.23 South Long by Chron 22.54 West

Remarks Saturday Nov 10th
First part Fresh Breezes from Eastward
steering different courses one sail in sight
broke out for reef repairing the Boat at 6 took
in sail at 8 at 11 made sail

Remarks Sunday Nov 11th
Fresh Breezes from Southward steering
by the wind to Westward at 6 took in
sail at 8 at 11 made sail and wore ship
to eastward
