Remarks on board Sunday Nov 23 1838

Light breeze from Northward at 4
finished cutting 3 sails in sight
at 11 commenced boiling

Remarks Saturday Nov 24th

Calm with light breeze from Northward
steering different courses employed boiling
Lat 35 42 Long by Obs 23 40 W

Remarks Sunday Nov 25th

Light breeze from Northward steering
to Westward at 4 finished boiling the

latter part employed stowing down oil
saw Right Whales lowered the Boats

x pastened down and came on board
5 sails in sight so ends Lat 35 45 W
Long by Chron 24 13 W

Remarks Monday Nov 26th

x First part light breeze from Northward
steering different courses saw Right Whales
lowered the Boats at 1 came along side
at 1 1/2 part off again at 3 came on board
and finished stowing down at 5 1/2 lowered
again spoke the Phoenix of Copenhagen
Boat at 6 came on board the latter

part Wind N W W 3 sails in sight and
several Finback Whales ^{several} so ends
Lat 35 55 South Long by Chron 24 10 W
Long by Obs 24 19 West

Remarks Tuesday Nov 27th

First part Fresh breeze from Northward
steering different courses 3 sails in sight
and Finbacks latter part Cloudy

Remarks Wednesday Nov 28th

Fresh breeze from Northward steering
different courses one sail in sight
caught a Porpoise Lat 35 South
Long by Chron 25 45 West

Atlantic Ocean on Barque Georg. Washin

Remarks Thursday Nov 29th 1838

First part Fresh breeze at 8
calm the middle and latter
parts calm a Gale from N W W
trying to N E at 8 wore ship

Remarks Friday Nov 30th

First part a Gale from N W W
trying to N E the middle and
latter parts Fresh breeze from
N W W Course N W W 2 sails in
sight saw Finbacks broke out
for provisions so ends
Lat South Long by Chron 25 11 W

Remarks Saturday December 1st 1838

Fresh breeze from N W W and pleasant
steering N E at 4 spoke the
Phoenix of Copenhagen & Whales
Capt. Lister came on board at 5 returned
parted the Fib stay and spliced it
saw Finbacks at 7 took in sail
the latter part made sail so ends
Lat 35 22 South Long by Chron 25 32 West

Remarks Sunday Dec 2nd

First part Fresh breeze from N W W
steering N East spoke out for water

x saw Finbacks at 7 took in sail
and wore ship at 11 at 11 wore all
sail ^{at 6} course N W W at 11 saw a
Right Whale going to windward lowered
the Boats
Lat 35 23 Long by Chron 25 50 W

Remarks Monday Dec 3rd

First part Fresh breeze parted the foot rope
to the main topgallant sail at 12 Boats
came on board 2 sails in sight and several
Finbacks course N W W at 7 took in
sail the middle and latter parts fresh
Gales and foggy so ends Lat 35 46 South
Long by Chron 25 31 West
