Remarks on board Tuesday Decr 4th 1855

X First part fresh Gale from N N W
and rainy steering N S West at
7 wore ship to E East at 11 the
wind shifted to S Eastward steering
to S Westward by the wind at 4th
at 6 made Sail at 7 Bore North
at 8 saw a Bright Whale at 8th foggy
and rainy lost sight of the Whale
took in sail so ends
Lat 36 00 South

Remarks Wednesday Decr 5th

X First part Fresh Breeze from S S E
and foggy steering S Westward by the
wind the latter part pleasant weather
Bore of East wind S S East
at 8 saw 2 right Whales and several
Sinkerbacks lowered the Boats fastened
lost the line so ends
Lat 36 06 South Long by Chron 24 02

Remarks Thursday Decr 6th

X Fresh Breeze from S S E at 1
Boats come along side and put off
again after the Whale spoke the
Barque Noble of with 8
Whales at 2 come on board at 4 saw
a carcass and a Bright Whale lowered
the Boats at 6 come on board at 7
took in sail steering by the Wind
to S West at 4th at 6 saw a Bright
Whale lowered the Boats at 7 come on
board saw Sinkerbacks at 9 bent the Main
Sagabontsail at 10 saw a Bright Whale
lowered the Boats at 11 came on board
so ends with very light Breeze

Remarks on board Friday Decr 7th 1855

X First part light airs from S Eastward
at 1 saw a Bright Whale lowered the
Boats at 2 come on board at 4th lowered
again at 4th come on board took in
sail a sail to leeward the latter part
light Breeze from S W and pleasant
saw Sinkerbacks 2 Sails in sight at
8 saw a Bright Whale going to
windward so ends
Lat 35 41 South Long by Chron 23 53 W

Remarks Saturday Decr 8th

light Breeze from S W and pleasant
steering by the wind to N N W
2 sails in sight saw Sinkerbacks at
7 took in sail and wore ship to
S S E the latter part made all sail
Lat 35 15 South Long by Chron 23 50 W
Long by Obs 23 40 West

Remarks Sunday Decr 9th

First part Calm on sail and 8 carcasses
in sight at 4 lowered the Starboard
Boat and went to one of the carcasses
at 7 took in sail the middle part light
Breeze from S S E Bore N N W the
latter part Fresh Breeze Bore S W 2
Sails in sight
Lat 35 02 S Long by Chron 24 37 W

Remarks Monday Decr 10th

X First part Fresh Gale from N by East
and cloudy at 1th saw Bright Whales
lowered the Boats at 4th come on board
2 sails in sight at 7 took in sail
and wore ship to Eastward the middle
part rainy the latter part fresh Breeze
from Westward steering South one sail
in sight saw Sinkerbacks
Lat 36 20 South Long by Chron 24 19 W
by lunar 24 50 W
