Remarks on board Tuesday 11th 1835

X First part Fresh Gale from Westward steering
to Northward the latter part Calm C B
East saw Right Whales lowered fastened
Trove craned so ends took in Main sail and Jib
Lat 36 12 South Long by Chron 24 30
Long by Obs 24 23 West

Remarks Wednesday Decr 12th

X First part Fresh Gale from Westward
steering Northward saw Right Whales
lowered the Boats at 4 came on board took
in the Fore Topsail the latter more
moderate made sail at 9 saw a Right
Whale going to Windward lowered the
Boats and chased at 11 came on board
3 sails in sight Lat 35 S Long by Chron 24 31

Remarks Thursday Decr 13th

X Light breeze and pleasant steering
Southward 3 Sails to Windward
at 4 saw 2 Right Whales to windward
lowered the Boats and pulled up
to windward but a ship to windward
struck the Whale at 6 came on board
at 7 took in sail the latter part made Sails
employed repairing the Main sail so ends
Lat 36 52 South Long by Chron 24 30 West

Remarks Friday Decr 14th

First part Fresh Gale from NW
steering by the Wind to Northward
2 Sails in sight at 3 bent the Main sail
and set it at 4 took in Sail the latter
part Light breeze from C B W and
bazy steering to Westward so ends
3 Sails in sight

Whaling voyage

Remarks on board Saturday Decr 15th 1835

X First part Fresh breeze from
NW steering to the SE Eastward
at 7 took in Sail the latter
part made all sail at 8 saw
Right Whales lowered the Boats
at 10 came on board 10th lowered
the Boats at 11 came on board
Lat 36 10 South

Remarks Sunday Decr 15th

First part Fresh breeze from
NW steering to the SE at 7 took
in Sail and luffed to Wind

the middle and latter part Fresh Gale
and from NW and rainy at 9 AM
spoke the Henry of Sagharbour Capt
..... with 5 Whales the 2^d male came
on board at 10 returned so ends headed
to S Westward
Lat S Long West

Remarks Monday Decr 17th

Fresh Gale from NW and rainy
steering to South Westward at 5 were
Ship at 7 took in the Foresail at 8 AM
set the Foresail and Topsail double
bunt so ends and were Ship Coors

Remarks Tuesday Decr 18th

First part Fresh Gale from NW
Coors East at 5 luffed to SE at 7
took in the Fore Topsail at 4 AM set
it double reefed and turned a reef out
the Main and set the Jib the latter
part Bazy so ends
Lat South Long West
