Remarks on board Wednesday Decr 19th 1838

First part light Breeze from NW
and rainy. The latter part pleasant
made all sail at 8 saw a Right Whale and several
finbacks lowered the Boat at 11¹/₂ came
on board got nothing so ends
Lat 35 45 South Long by Chron 20 58

Remarks Thursday Decr 20th

First part light Breeze from Westward
and pleasant at 4¹/₂ saw a Right Whale
lowered the Boat at 7 came on board
and took in sail the latter part light
Breeze from N East steering E S E
at 10 took in Foresail Fitch the sail the Sails
thick foggy weather saw finbacks
Lat 35 00 S Long by Chron 21 15

Remarks Friday Decr 21st

First part Fresh Breeze from
N E W any foggy Course South
saw finbacks set the Fore Topsail
at 4 Course S E W at 8 took in
sail the latter part a Gale from
N W by E and rainy wore ship
look up the Foggy Course South
Long by Chron 21 15 by Obs 17 50 W

Remarks Saturday Decr 22^d

First part a Gale from N W

trying to N Eastward set the
Foresail the middle and latter
parts Fresh Gale from S W
set 4 A H set the Fore Topsail
couldn't reefed and turned a reef saw
the Chain at 7 went the Foresail
to repair and set the Gile at 10
parted the rope of the Chain Sails
one sail in sight so ends

Lat 35 45 Long by Obs 18 40 W

Whaling Voyage

Remarks on board Sunday Decr 23, 1838

First part Fresh Gale from S W
steering N E W by the wind
at 8 bent the Foresail and set
it broke out for reef at 9 took
in sail the latter part made all sail
saw finbacks calm so ends
Lat 35 10 South Long West

Remarks Monday Decr 24th

First part light Breeze from
North steering by the wind to N E W
at 9 took in sail Fresh Breeze
and rainy the middle and latter part
a Gale from North trying to Westward
at Midnight called all hands took in
the Foresail and Main Boat the latter
part the wind calmed to Westward at
10 took in ship Wind S W so ends
Lat 35 33 South

Remarks Tuesday Decr 25th

First part a Gale from S West set the
Foresail the middle part Fresh Breeze
the latter part light Breeze from S W
steering Northward made sail and worked
the Chain Sails to repair saw a whale
feed so ends Lat 35 03 South
Long by Chron 21 08 by Obs 26 08 West

Remarks Wednesday Decr 26th

First part light Breeze from Westward
employed repairing the Sail at 3
saw a Right Whale going to Southward
quick lowered the Boat at 4 came
on board got nothing at 7 bent the
Foresail and took in sail saw a
finback the middle part the wind
shifted to S E steering by the wind
to S W at 4 A H made sail at 5
Course N by E at 10 the wind S W
tacked ship to N E W saw a sail
saw finbacks in sight
Lat 35 14 South
