Remarks on board Thursday Dec 27th
First part Fresh Gale from S W
and variable steering by the wind
Westward saw Sigsbecks the wind
changed to Westward at 12 look in
Sail wind W by S at 4 o'clock made
all sail wind S West so end

Remarks Friday Dec 28th
First part Fresh Gale from N S W
and squally at 2 the wind blowing stronger
took in Topsails and reefed the
Topsails at 4 took in Gib and Main sail
wind S by W course West at 5 1/2 look
in the Fore Topsail and bore the ship
to a Gale from S by East at 7 o'clock
look in the Fore sail at 4 1/2 o'clock set
the Fore sail and Topsail close reefed
at 6 course W by S a sail of the tea
the latter part turned a reef out the
Topsails set the Sprigantail and in chain
sail and Gaft Topsail so end
Sat 33, 46 South Song by Chron 20 West

Remarks Saturday Dec 29th
First part Fresh Breeze from S by E
and pleasant course West at 12 look in
sail and luffed to the Wind at 4 o'clock
made sail the latter part calm employed
fitting repairing the Main rigging and
staying the Topsails saw Sigsbecks
Sat 33 48 Song by Chron W

Remarks Sunday Dec 30th First part
light Breeze from W by S and pleasant
steering S W by S at 7 look in
Sail the middle part course S W by S
wind W by S at 4 o'clock made sail the
latter part course S W saw Sigsbecks
so end Sat 34 27 South

Whaling voyage

Remarks on board Monday Dec 31st 1838

Fresh Breeze from S W course S W
at 4 o'clock luffed to the wind at 7 1/2 look
in Sail wind S W by S at 4 o'clock
made sail steering by the wind to W by S
at 8 saw a carcass misty weather
Sat South Song West

Remarks Tuesday Jan 1st 1839
Fresh Gale from S W by S and
foggy at 4 rainy weather saw 2 right
Whales, lowered 2 Boats at 4 1/2 came on
board at 5 1/2 lowered again at 6 came on board
took in the Fore Topsail middle and
at 5 o'clock hauled by the Concorda and spoke for
latter part Foggy weather set the
Fore Topsail close reefed at
luffed a reef out the Topsails and more ship
set the Gib at 6 o'clock more ship
Sat 35 92 South
Song by Chron 24 13 W

Remarks Wednesday Jan 2nd
First part Fresh Gale from West
and foggy steering S S West a sail
ahead at 3 saw a right Whale lowered
2 Boats set in a thick fog lost sight
of the Whale at 6 came on board at
7 look in sail at 9 o'clock spoke the
Concorda at 4 o'clock spoke the
Hannable set the Fore Topsail close
reefed at 5 saw a right Whale lowered
the set in thick fog at 7 came on board
lost sight of the Whale the latter part
light Breeze and pleasant set all sail
8 sail in sight at 5 1/2 a Barque to
leeward saw 3 Whales lowered the Boat
at 9 saw the Whales lowered the Boat
and chased the Whales at 10 o'clock came on
board so end
