Remarks on board Thursday Jan^y 3^d 1839
First part light breeze from N S W
and pleasant several sails in sight at
10 saw 2 Whales going to Windward
quick lowered the Boat at 3 came ash
board at 4 took in sail headed N W
at 4 A M wore Ship to West
wind N W W made all sail
3 sails in sight at 9 saw 2
Right Whales lowered the Boat
at 10 came on board calm weather
sailed Sat South Long 28

Remarks Friday Jan^y 4th
First part light breeze from N
steering Westward 3 sails in
sight at 6 spoke the Stephania
of New Bedford Capt Bourne
18 months 21 o'clock till joined with
her at 7 took in sail the middle
and latter parts foggy

Remarks Saturday Jan^y 5th
Fresh breeze from N Westward
and foggy the latter part made
all sail

Remarks Sunday Jan^y 6th
First part calm and raining at
4 A light breeze from N W and
raining at 7 took in sail at 9
wore Ship to N W blowing
Fresh Gale from N W and
raining at 9 called all hand took
in the foresail the middle part wind
N W W steering West at 4 A M set the
fore Sloop at the latter part repaired the
foresail one new buntlines and set it
one sail in sight
Sat 36 49 South Long by Chron 25, 11

Whaling Voyage

Remarks on board Monday Jan^y 7th 1839
First part Fresh breeze from N W
and pleasant set the fore steering West
at 10 took in sail a sail to leeward
at 4 A M light breeze from Eastward made
all sail steering by the Wind to Southward
the latter part came South 3 sails in sight
Sat South Long by Chron West

Remarks Tuesday Jan^y 8th
First part light breeze from East to N E East
came South at 3 spoke the Two Brothers
of New Bedford Capt Howland 80 days
out one Whale at 7 took in sail
and headed to Eastward wind N E E
and cloudy at 4 A M made all sail
came South the latter part foggy
Sat 35 36 South
Long by Chron 25 30 West

Remarks Wednesday Jan^y 9th
Fresh breeze from N E East
steering by the wind to N West
at 4 foggy parted the Boat rope to the
fore Sloop sail furled it at 5 o'clock close
repaired the Main at 5 A M made all
sail a breeze from N W W and
pleasant came N W at 8 saw 2 sails
at other saw 2 Right Whales going
to Windward quick
Sat 38 25 South
Long by Chron 21 12 by Chron 21 19 W

Remarks Thursday Jan^y 10th
light breeze from N S W and
pleasant came N W at 2 saw a
Right Whale going to Windward
quick lowered the Boat and chased
at 4 came on board at 7 took
in sail saw grampuses Wind West by
North wind Northward it 3 more ships
the latter part rainy at 3 A M made
sail
