First part calm employed making
a light Sloop sail out of lower steering
sail at 7^{1/2} took in sail the middle
and latter parts light Breeze from
N Westward steering by the wind
to Westward at 4 of AM made all
sail employed ^{at 10 AM} ^{that} ^{lead} ^{and} ^{what} ^{lowered}
