Remarks on board Sunday Jan 20th 1839

First part light Breeze from
NW by N and pleasant hours
at 11 sent up the Mizzen Topmast
and bent the Gaff Topsail at
12 caught a porpoise at 1 1/2 took in
sail Capt Wilber went on board
the latter part made all sail the Mast
in company with S W so ends

Lat 38 40 South
Long by Chron 37 30
by Obs 36 20 West

Remarks Monday Jan 21st
light Breeze from North East
S W 2 sails in sight at 6 heeled
to W by South at 9 at 11 fresh
Gale from S W and squally more
ship took in fore and aft sail
Main sail double reefed the Topsail
the Washington in company
so ends Lat 39 South
Long West

Remarks Tuesday Jan 22nd
First part fresh Gales from
S W heading to Westward at
4 wind NW heading S W at 6
at 7 Gale from S W took in the fore topsail
and double reefed the Main and
were ship to W of W at 8 at 11
set the fore topsail close reefed
a sail of the weather Breeze so ends
Lat South Long by Chron W

Remarks Wednesday Jan 23rd
First part a Gale from W of W
trying to Northward at 4 wore ship
and took in the fore topsail at
5 took in the fore sail and reefed
the Main topsail over at 6 at 11
set the fore sail and topsail at 7
set the Main sail at 9 set the fore
a sail to forward so ends steering
W of W Lat 39 15 South
Long by Chron 38 04

to the falls Bant's
Remarks on board Thursday Jan 24th 1839
First part fresh Gales from S W
steering W of W by the wind
on sail to forward at 7 1/2 took in
sail at 5 at 11 made all sail
wind S W by S and pleasant
the Washington in company so ends
Lat 38 39 S Long by Chron 38 34 W

Remarks Friday Jan 25th 1839
fresh Breeze from S W by S and
pleasant at 1 saw Black Fish toward
the Boat in company with the Mast
at 2 came on board got nothing
at 4 1/2 took in sail at 5 at 11
made all sail employed repairing
the Main topsail at 8 lashed ship
to S S W wind S so ends
Lat South Long by Chron W

Remarks Saturday Jan 26th
fresh Breeze from West and pleasant
steering S S W employed repairing
the Main topsail at 7 took in fore
and aft sail and double reefed the topsails
at 5 at 11 made all sail at 6
saw Right Whales and Sperm
low the Boat at 7 came on board
at 9 lowered again at 12 came
on board 2 sails in sight
Lat 40 05 Long by Chron 38

Remarks Sunday Jan 27th
light Breeze from W of W
and pleasant at 2 spoke the
corinthian of Bristol Capt W. H. Jones
went on board at 5 returned
at 7 took in sail at 4 at 11 made
all sail so ends
Lat 40 57 S Long by Chron W
