Remarks on board Sunday February 5th 1839

First part Fresh Gale from NW at 10 steering
by the wind to Southward at 3 finished
stowing down the fore Ship at 6
at 11 took in the Foresail a Gale
so ends Lat 41 42 Long by Chron 43 10 W

Remarks Wednesday February 6th

First part a Gale from NW at 10
trying to N Westward at 3 set the
Foresail at 7 close reefed the Main
Sopsail at 3 at 11 set the fore Sopsail
close reefed and turned a reef out
the Main so ends Lat 41 42 Long by Chron 43 35

Remarks Thursday Feb 7th

First part Gale from NW at 10
trying to NW at 7 took in
the fore Sopsail the latter part
Moderate made all sail at 11 saw
a right Whale lowered the Boats
so ends Lat 41 42 Long by Chron 43 10 West

Remarks Friday Feb 8th

First part light Breeze from
Westward and pleasant at 1 Boats
come on board got nothing steering
by the NW by 11 caught a
porpoise at 7 took in sail at 5 AM
made all sail wind NW steering
NW at 11 employed repairing the
Foresail saw Sinker at 9 lowered
the Boat for the Sinker at 10 came
on board at Merchant the fore
Sail and bent the other so ends
Lat 40 20 Long by Chron 43 00

Remarks Saturday Feb 9th

Fresh Breeze from NW at 10 steering
by the wind to Westward saw a
Bright Whale lowered 2 Boats at 1 1/2
come on board the Whale pursued
the Ship took out the After hold
and stowed the Sail in cargo at
7 took in sail at 11 AM made all sail

at 10 saw Bright Whale lowered
2 Boats reefed the Sopsails Fresh Gale
at 11 came on board the Whale
going to Windward gyrate so ends
Lat 40 20 Long by Chron 46 26

Remarks on board Sunday Feb 10th

First part Fresh Gale from
NW at 2 lowered 2 Boats the
Ship frightened the Whale at 3 came
on board took in Main sail the
Spanker at 6 took in the fore
Sopsail the latter part the Boat
parted took it in and mended it
fresh Gale and raining at 7 more
Ship Na 11

Remarks on board Monday Feb 11th

First Fresh Breeze from NW
at 1 and foggy at 7 set the fore
Sopsail and wore Ship to NW
at 7 took in fore Sopsail saw
porpoises at 5 AM light Breeze from
SW wore Ship to NW and made
all sail saw Porpoises and Sinker
broke out the after hold for Provision
so ends

Remarks Tuesday Feb 12th

First part fresh Breeze from SW at 10
and pleasant employed repairing the fore
Sopsail took in Sopsail and trouble
reefed the Sopsails at 7 took in sail
at 1 1/2 took all sail the latter part
repairing the fore Sopsail so ends Course
West Lat 40 Long 44

Remarks Wednesday Feb 13th

First part fresh Breeze from South
steering by the wind to Westward
at 4 unhooked the fore Sopsail and
bent the other at 1 1/2 took in sail
at 1 at 11 wind NW at 11 Course SW
at 11 made all sail wind NW
the latter part unhooked the fore
Sopsail and altered it so ends
Lat 40 00 Long 44
