First part light Breeze from N.W.
and pleasant Course S.W. West the
Gaff Topsail at 7 1/2 took in sail
the latter part light Breeze
to end S Sat 40 38 South
Song by Chon 48 39

Remarks Friday February 15th
First part light Breeze from
N.W. East and pleasant Course
S.W. West at 7 1/2 took in sail
to double reefed topsail and fore
sail at 4 1/2 & 1/2 turned the reefs out
and set the Sappalant sail so ends
Sat 41 38 Song by Chon 49 58 58

Remarks Saturday February 16th
First part fresh Breeze and pleasant
Course S.W. West at 4 the matter centered
at 7 1/2 took in Sappalant sail double
reefed the topsails sounder no bottom
at 4 1/2 & 1/2 turned the reefs out the topsail
at 6 set the Sappalant sail at 6 1/2 rainy
Fresh Gale from E & East and rainy
at 8 took in Sappalant sail and double
reefed the topsails at 9 took in the fore
topsail and hove the ship to to Eastward
at Eastward so ends at 11 1/2

Remarks Sunday February 17th
First part a Gale from the Eastward
trying to Southward at 4 1/2 took in
the fore sail and close reefed the main
topsail at midnight as we stove the starboard
boat called all hands and turned it up on the
cranes so ends at 11 1/2 all well

Remarks Monday February 18th
A Gale from Eastward trying to
Southward the latter part took in the
starboard boat fixed the Babstey and set
it up so ends Sat 43 40
Song by Chon 52 20

Whaling voyage in the Atlantic Ocean
Remarks on board Tuesday February 19th 1859
First part Fresh Gale from S.E.
Course N.E. West set the fore topsail
double reefed turning a reef out the
main at 4 1/2 & 1/2 made all sail
so ends Sat 44 30 South
Song by Chon 55 28 44

Remarks Wednesday Feb 20th
Fresh Breeze from E & East
and pleasant Course S.W. West
at 6 1/2 took in sail at 10
left to wind at 5 & 1/2 made
all sail Course West wind North
so ends Sat 44 05 South
Song by Chon 58 00 West

Remarks Thursday Feb 21st
First part Fresh Gale from
N.W. by N and pleasant steering
N by E at 7 1/2 took in sail
and sounded no bottom at 11 1/2 caught
a Porpoise at 4 1/2 & 1/2 made all sail
wind North the latter part Course
West so ends Sat 43 51 South

Remarks Friday February 22nd
Fresh Breeze from North and West
Course N.E. West at 7 took in sail
and sounded 55 fathoms the middle
and latter part equally at 11 1/2 set the fore topsail

Remarks Saturday Feb 23rd
Fresh Gale from E East and
Squally rainy steering by the wind
to Westward at 5 noon ship 80
fathoms matter at 7 took in the
fore topsail the middle and latter
parts wind S.W. West at 3 1/2 & 1/2 took
in the Main Boat and turned up the
starboard Boat found the Main Mast to be
rotten
