moderate made all sail so ends
Lat 43 19 South

Remarks Monday February 25th
First part light Breeze from C
W and pleasant steering to New
ward put the Starboard boat on
the Decks at 5 tack'd ship at 12
took in sail at midnight light Breeze
from C S W four C S S W at 5 AM
made sail the latter part broke out
for provisions so ends Lat 43 40 South
Long by Chron 59. 15 West

Remarks Tuesday Feb 26th
First part Fresh Gale from C S W
and pleasant four C S W at 7 took in
sail four C S East at 9 four C S by 8
the latter part four C S W wind
North made all sail so ends
Lat 44 51 C S
Long by Chron 59. 08 West

Remarks Wednesday 27th
First part light Breeze from
North and pleasant four C S W
at 7 took in sail steering by the
wind to Westward sounded no bottom
at 5 AM put the Waist Boat on
the cranes set the Fore Topsail Gangle
up and furl Chainsail Sparker and
turned the reef out the Main
Sapsail so ends 44 55 South
Long by Chron 58. 45 West

Remarks Thursday Feb 28th
First part Fresh Gale from
C S W and pleasant four C S W
took in Gib and Sparker at
6 AM saw a Right Whale at 7 came
on board took in sail and wore ship
60 fathoms Water at 5 AM set
the Fore Sapsail at 6 four C S W
at 10 four C S so ends Lat 44 53 South
60 fathoms

Whaling voyage 1839
Remarks on board Friday March 1st
First part light Breeze from C S W
steering by the wind to Westward
at 3 had a thunder squall took in
sail and wore ship the middle and
latter parts a Gale from C S to South
took in the Waist Boat so ends
C S S W

Remarks Saturday March 2d
First part a Gale from South
the middle and latter parts Fresh
Breeze from C S S W and squally
at 6 AM four C S East so ends
53 fathoms water Lat 45 14
Long by Chron 61. 08

Remarks Sunday March 3d
Light Breeze from C S Westward and
squally four C S S W at 2 saw Right
Whale going to windward guids the
middle part by the wind the latter part
four C S East so ends Lat 44 32 C S
75 fathoms water

Remarks Monday March 4th
Light Breeze from Westward and four
four C S East that 7 took in the Fore
Sapsail sounded no bottom heaved by the
wind to Southward at 5 AM made sail
wind C S W four C S caught a porpoise
opened a Bl Blower filled some casks
with water for ballast so ends
Lat 43 35 South
Long by Chron 58 49 West

Remarks Tuesday March 5th
First part Fresh Breeze from
C S W four C S East at 4 took in
sail at 5 AM made all sail
four C S East wind C S W at 8
four C S by 6 so ends
Lat 43 07 South
Long by Chron 58. 01
Long by Obs 58. 03
