at 11 made sail cours ENE
so ends Sat 39 54

Remarks Sunday March 24th
First part light Breezes from
South and pleasant cours ENE
at 5 took in sail the middle
part wind S W the latter part
wind S South made all sail
so ends Sat 39 22 South

Remarks Monday March 25
Light Breezes from S Westward
and pleasant cours ENE at 5
took in sail at 5 at 11 made
all sail so ends Sat 38 41 South

Remarks Tuesday March 26th
First part light Breezes from
S Westward and pleasant cours
ENE started a calk of water
filled up three calks with salt
water stowed of the hold at 5 took
in sail at ends 5 at 11 made
sail cours E East broke out
the fore hold for wood so
Sat 37 45 South
Long by Chron 38 10

Remarks Wednesday March 27th
First part fresh Breezes from Southward
cours E by East at 5 took in sail
at midnight wind E by E at 5 at 11
made all sail wind E so ends
So ends

Remarks Thursday March 28th
Fresh Gale from NNE East and
strong starting by the wind to NNE at 6
took in sail wore ship the middle
and latter parts a Gale from North
and rainy took in the waist Boat and
turned up the Quarter Boats at 11
the wind NNE NNE at 11

Remarks on board Friday March 29th

A Gale from NNE W and
squally trying to Northward at 2 set
the fore sail and topsail at 5 took
them in the fore topsail at 8
then took in the topsail close
reefed the main topsail so ends
Sat 36 48 South

Remarks Saturday March 30th
A Gale from NNE W and
squally trying to Northward
Sat 36 38 South

Remarks Sunday March 31st
First part a Gale from NNE
W and squally trying to Northward
the middle and latter part more
moderate set courses fore
topsail turned a reef out the main
set the jib and spraker
Sat 36 09 South

Remarks Monday April 1st
Fresh Breezes from NNE W
and pleasant starting NNE at 5
took in sail at 5 at 11 made
sail broke out the after hold
for Molasses and sugar so ends
Sat 35 26 South

Remarks Sunday April 2nd
First part fresh Gales from
NNE W cours NNE at 5
took in sail the middle and
latter part wind NNE starting
by the wind to North set the
fore topsail so ends
Sat 34 17 South
