 at 9 made sail at 10 could be
 reefed the topsails at 6 took
 in fore topsail at 11

Remarks Saturday April 13th
 Fresh Breeze from E East
 and cloudy course N E by N at
 5 took in the fore sail and
 topsail headed by the wind to
 E at 8 at 10 set the fore
 sail and topsail course North
 at 8 the main Sunam fell out
 the chain rigging on deck and
 hurt figure so ends
 Lat 29 05 South
 Long 89 45 West

Remarks Sunday April 14th
 Light breezes from E East and
 squally course North at 6 took
 in sail headed to Eastward at 8
 at 10 made sail course North
 wind South so ends at 11
 and Sunam no better
 Lat 26 35 South
 Long by Chron 40 12 West

 Fresh Breeze from E East and squally
 course N W at 6 took sail by by
 the wind to Eastward at 5 at 8
 made sail course N took up the anchor
 out the fore block sent up the Royal
 Masts and Yards sent out the fore
 Jib Boom & course N W W
 Lat 25 36 South
 Long by Chron 40 25 West

Remarks Tuesday April 16th
 Fresh Breeze from E East and
 squally course N W at 6 took
 in sail luffed to Eastward at 5
 at 10 made sail course N W
 at 10 luffed to Eastward thick and
 rainy took in the fore topsail
 so ends at 11

Remarks Wednesday April 17th
 Fresh Breeze from E East
 and squally course N W by N
 put the anchors out and bent
 the cable set the fore topsail
 at 6 took in sail at 8 made
 all sail course N W wind South
 took out for water & and Provisions
 so ends Lat 23 42
 Long by Chron 42 15 West
 by Obs 40 50

Remarks Thursday April 18th
 First part Fresh Breeze from South
 and pleasant course N W by West
 at 2 made the land near Cape
 Horn steering by the wind to Westward
 the middle part squally at 5 at 8
 put up towards Rio Janeiro light Breeze
 and pleasant the land in sight near
 Rio just 30 miles so ends
