Remarks on board Friday April 19th
light breeze from Eastward steering
steering in towards Rio de Janeiro at 9
tacked off the light off the Harbour and
sight the middle part being off and on
at 4 PM put away for the Harbour
several sails in sight the latter part
light breeze from East so ends

Remarks Saturday April 20th
light breeze from East and pleasant
at 4 comes to anchor in 20 fathoms
water several boats come on board
at 9 AM weighed anchor and haled the
Barge in at 10 come to anchor at 11
Capt Whitens went on shore

Remarks Sunday April 21st
light breeze and pleasant at 7 Capt Whitens
came on board at 8 PM part of the crew
ashore on liberty William J Spence went
on shore to the Doctor Capt W went on shore

Remarks Monday April 22nd
light breeze and pleasant at 7 the Liberty
men come on board all but Peter Swann
at toward 10 AM Montgomery Boat Sailed
at 5 PM the above men come on board
and Capt Whitens at 11 Capt returned on
shore so ends. Swann Montgomery sick a part
of the crew on liberty

Remarks Tuesday April 23rd
light breeze and pleasant and a survey on the
the Main Mast where it was damaged at 5 the
men on the survey went ashore. Let go
the Starboard Anchor have in part of the
harbord cable carried the Barge anchor out
then hove up the Starboard Anchor at
7 the Liberty men come on board all but
William Ross. the latter part hove
up the Anchor and a line to a yard
vessel along the Anchor and let go
the Starboard anchor unhook the Main sail
top sail and top galant sail so ends

Remarks Wednesday April 24th
pleasant weather the first employed
the yards and Masts to be off the
latter part broke out the Main
hatchway to get at the Whale Rib &
lunched up the bone saunders

Remarks Thursday April 25th
pleasant weather at 5 sent a launch to
the ship to take the Barge ashore
William Ross come on board at 4 PM
commenced breaking out the Rib at 10 finished
and carried it ashore carried the bone ashore

Remarks Friday April 26th
pleasant weather commenced stowing
off the hold and filling with water
the latter part employed taking the rigging of
the Mainmast and clearing it to take out
and getting up shears

Remarks Saturday April 27th
Pleasant weather the first part took out
the Main Mast the part towed the Mast
ashore and fitted the rigging so ends

Remarks Sunday April 28th
Pleasant weather first part employed fitting
rigging the latter part a part of the crew
on liberty so ends

Remarks Monday April 29th
pleasant weather at 6 part of the Liberty
men come on board at 9 AM the Liberty
men come on board all but Peter Swann
and Joseph Horton at 10 the remainder
of the crew went on Liberty John
Horton departed from the boat the latter part
had 4 callers to work on the ship

Remarks Tuesday April 30th
Pleasant weather at the Liberty men come on
board all but Min Ross departed at the latter
part had 5 callers to work at shore Peter Swann
come on board
