Sunday July 14th 1899 First Part calm weather saw a
Plenty of Fin Back at 4 P.M. sent up the main top
gallant yard at 5 P.M. took in sail for the night
Heading to the Eastward Middle & Part Light Breeze from the N.W.
Heading to the S.W. Latter Part Wind Breeze from the S.W. with
Pleasant weather at Day Light Made sail and Steered south saw
Fin Backs lowered the boats and I shared at meridian same Onboard
Lat 30.55 South Long 39.45 West

Remarks Onboard

Monday July 15th First Part Strong Breeze from the N.W.
and Pleasant weather Steering south lowered the boats and
got fast to a Fin Back But did not have time to haul Onboard
at 8 P.M. took in sail for the night and Breeze ship to the
S & Middle and Latter Strong Gale from the Northward Heading
to the N.E. Under main top sail and fore sail and May sails
Employed in ships Duty Lat 30.59 South

Tuesday July 16th First Part Strong Gale from the Northward
Heading to the N.E. Under main top sail fore sail and May sails
at 4 P.M. took in the fore sail Middle and Latter Part Strong Gale
from the N.W. & W. Heading to the N.W. at 8 P.M. Breeze ship
to the S.W. saw Fin Backs got out a cask of Water and one
of Bread and a fifth of Meat Employed in ships Duty Lat 30.40 South
Long 38.42 West

Wednesday July 17th First Part Strong Gale from the N.W. & W.
Heading to the S.W. saw Fin Backs at 6 P.M. took in the fore sail
and Breeze ship to the N.W. Middle Part the same Latter Part
Latter Part Breeze ship to the Eastward Strong Gale from the S.E.
saw Fin Backs Lat 30.24 South Long 38.50 West

Thursday July 18th First Part Strong Gale from the S & W heading
to the Eastward Under main top sail fore sail and May sails at 6
P.M. Breeze ship to the S.W. and took in the fore sail Middle
Part the same Latter Part calm weather saw Fin Backs
Lat 30.20 South Long 37.13 West

Friday July 19th First Part Moderate Breeze from the S.E. &
and Pleasant weather Steering to the S.E. Under all sail saw
Fin Backs at 8 P.M. took in sail for the night Middle Part
the same Latter Part Strong Gale from the Eastward and equally
weather Steering to the Southward Lat 31.07 South

Saturday July 20th First Part Strong Gale from the Eastward
and squally weather Heading to the S.E. at 6 P.M. took in the fore
sail and set the fore May sail Middle Part the same Latter Part
Strong Breeze from the N.E. Steering S.W. Lat 31.55 South

Sunday July 21st First Part Strong Breeze from the N.E. Steering
S.W. Under Double Reef top sails at 6 P.M. suff to the fore to the
S & Middle Part the same Latter Moderate Breeze from the N.E. and
Pleasant weather Steering S.W. saw Fin Backs
Lat 32.41 South Long by Lunar 38.05 West 38.25 by Chron

Monday July 22nd First Part Moderate Breeze from the S.E.
and Pleasant weather Steering S.W. at 6 P.M. took in the
fore top sail and Luffed to the fore to S & Middle Part the same
Latter Part Strong Breeze from the Northward set the fore top sail
and Steered N.W. Lat 33.23 South

Tuesday July 23rd First Part Strong Breeze from the N.W. Steering
N.W. Employed in ships Duty at 6 P.M. took in the fore sail and fore
top sail suff to the N.W. Middle Part Heading to the south Latter Part
Strong Breeze from the S.W. Breeze ship to the S.E. Under Double
Reef top sails started a cask of Water Lat 33.52 South
