Wednesday August 14th 1839
 First Part Light Breeze from the S. S. E. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the Southward Employed Repairing the Main Top Sail Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze from the N. N. E. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S. S. E. Saw two Blackbacks Bent the Main Top Sail and Luff of the Fore Sail as to Repair at Lat 31.22 South

Thursday August 15th
 First Part Light Breeze from the N. N. E. and Pleasant Weather Steering S. W. all Hands Employed Repairing the Fore Sail at 6 P.M. took in sail and Luff to the Wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter Part Fresh Breeze from the S. S. E. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S. S. E. Employed Repairing the Fore Sail and Other Jobs about the Ship Saw two Blackbacks Lat 31.31 South Long 92.47 by Lunar by Clock 34.05 West

Friday August 16th
 First Part Fresh Breeze from the S. S. E. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S. S. E. Employed Repairing the Fore Sail and Other Jobs about the Ship Saw a Barque Steering to the N. E. at 6 P.M. took in sail Repairing S. S. E. Middle and Latter Strong Breeze from the Northward at Day Light made sail and Steered S. W. Bent the Fore Sail Lat 32.09 South

Saturday August 17th
 First Part Strong Breeze from the Northward Steering S. W. Under Double Reef Top Sails and Fore Sail started a Gush of Water Saw two Blackbacks at 6 P.M. took in the Fore Sail and Fore Top Sail and Luff of the Main Top Sail and Luff to the Wind to the S. S. E. Middle Part the same Latter Part Strong Breeze north veered to the West at 11 A.M. took the Wind South by Heading West Bloating and Raining took in all sail except the Fore Spencer Luff of the Fore Top Sail

Sunday August 18th
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the South with Rain Heading to the Westward Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze from the S. S. E. Heading to the Southward Under Double Reef Top Sails Lat 32.30 South Long 94.48 Lunar 95.24 by Clock

Monday August 19th 1839
 First Part Light Breeze from the S. S. E. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the Southward Under Double Reef Top Sails at 8 P.M. took in sail Heading S. E. by the Wind Middle Part the same started a Gush of Wind at Day set the Fore Top Sail and Luff Heading to the S. E. Latter Part took in the Fore Top Sail and Fore Sail and Luff and Luff of the Main Top Sail following a Gale from the N. E. and Raining Lat South Long West

Tuesday August 20th
 First Part Blowing a Gale from the N. E. with squalls of Rain Heading to the S. E. Under Last Reef Main Top Sail and Reef Spencer Burned up the Lee Mast Heading S. E. by the Wind Middle Part the Wind veered to S. S. E. Stop Heading S. W. at 7 A.M. veered Ship to the Eastward Employed Repairing the Fore Top Sail Lat 33.12 South

Wednesday August 21st
 First Part a Gale from the Southward Heading to the Eastward Under Last Reef Main Top Sail and Fore Top Sail Bent the Fore Top Sail Heading to the East Middle and Latter Part the same set the Fore Sail Thick Weather with some squalls of Rain Lat 32.52 South

Thursday August 22nd
 First Part Strong Breeze from the S. E. with squalls of Rain Heading to the Southward Under Fore Sail at 6 P.M. took in the Fore Sail Heading South Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze from the N. E. and Foggy Steering South Lat 33.14 South

Friday August 23rd
 First Part Light Breeze from the N. E. and thick foggy weather Employed in Ship's Duties at 8 P.M. took in the Fore Sail and Luff to the Eastward Middle Part the same Latter Part Light Breeze from the Northward and thick weather Steering to the Southward Broke out fire, scattered and a Gush of Wind saw two Blackbacks saw a fish Steering to the S. E. Lat 33.54 South
