 and Squally Weather Heading to the Southward Under the Stay Sails
 Middle and Latter Part the same Lat 32.58 South

Thursday Sept 5th
 First Part Strong Gale from the Westward
 and thick Squally Weather Heading to the Southward Under
 the Stay Sails Middle Part the same Latter Part Moderate
 Breeze from the S.W. at 8 P.M. took in the Main Top Sail and Fore
 Sail, Steered North W. by E. but for Reef and Deck Employed
 About 10 P.M. Lat 32.35 South Long 31.90 West

Friday Sept 6th
 First Part Light Breeze from the Southward Steering
 North W. by E. at 8 P.M. took in the Main Top Sail and Fore
 Sail and at 10 P.M. the Wind to the Westward Middle
 Part the same Latter Part Light Breeze from the Southward and
 Pleasant Weather made sail and Steered to the S.W. Employed
 in Ships Duty started a back of Water Saw Fin Back
 Lat 32.18 South Long 32.00 West

Saturday Sept 7th
 First Part Light Breeze from the Southward
 and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S.W. Employed in Ships
 Duty at 8 P.M. took in Sail for the Night Heading to the S.W.
 Middle Part the same Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the South
 and Pleasant Weather made all sail Steered to the S.W. Saw
 Fin Backs and Porpoises Lat 31.51 South Long 32.14 West

Sunday Sept 8th
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the South
 and Pleasant Weather Steering to the Westward Under all sail
 Employed in Ships Duty at 6 P.M. Put the Lower Mast
 Main Top Sail and Stay Sails Heading West Middle Part the same
 Latter Part Strong Breeze partly set the Fore Sail and Fore Top Sail
 Headed Ship to the North Lat 32.00 South

of Falmouth on a Whaling Voyage in South Atlantic Ocean

Monday September 9th 1899
 First Part Strong Breeze from the
 Eastward Steering to the Westward Under the Main Top Sail and Stay Sails
 at 8 P.M. took in the Fore Sail and the Top Sail heading North
 Middle Part Strong Breeze from the Eastward and Rainy Weather
 to the S.W. Latter Part Strong Breeze from the North West Ship to
 the Eastward thick Rainy Weather

Tuesday Sept 10th
 First Part Strong Breeze from the S.W. and the
 Rainy Weather Heading N.E. took in the Main Top Sail Middle and Latter
 Part Moderate Breeze from the Westward and thick Rainy Weather
 set the Fore sail and Main Top Sail Heading to the Northward
 Broke Out for Water Glass Lat 31.48 South

Wednesday Sept 11th
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the Westward
 and thick Weather Heading to the Northward at 8 P.M. took in the
 Fore Sail Heading to the Northward Middle and Latter Part the same
 set the Fore Sail changed Fin Back Lat 30.20 South

Thursday Sept 12th
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the Westward
 and Cloudy Weather Steering to the S.W. changed Fin Backs at 8 P.M.
 took in Sail Heading S.W. Middle and Latter Part the same

Friday Sept 13th
 First Part Strong Breeze from S.W. and thick
 Rainy Weather Heading to the S.W. Under the Main Top Sail
 and Stay Sails Middle and Latter Part Strong Gale from the South
 Heading to the S.W. at 7 A.M. Headed Ship to the S.W. Lat 32.00 Long 32.15

Saturday Sept 14th
 First Part Strong Breeze from the Southward
 Heading to the S.W. Under short Reef Main Top Sail and Stay Sails
 Middle and Latter Part Calm Weather Employed in Ships
 Duty saw Fin Back Broke Out for Bread Lat 31.57 South
