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Sunday September 15 1839 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Light Breeze from the S.W. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S.W. Under Double Reefed Top Sails Saw Sun Backs at 8 P.M. took in Sail for the night Heading South Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze from the Northward and Pleasant Weather at Day Light Made sail and Steered to the Southward Sailed a Boat and Chased Heller Lat 32.29 South Long by Line 91.59 West by Lunas 91.43 West

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Monday Sept 16 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Light Breeze from the Northward and Pleasant Weather Steering to the Southward at 8 P.M. took in sail and Luffed to the Wind to the Eastward Middle and Latter Part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and Cloudy Set the Fore Sail and Fore Top Sail Steering to the S.E. Employed Repairing the Mizzen Stay Sail and Other Jobs about the Ship Lat 32.45 South

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Tuesday Sept 17 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Strong Breeze from the N.E. and Cloudy Weather Steering to the S.E. Under Double Reefed Top Sails at 8 P.M. Put the Under Mast Reef Main Top Sail and Stay Sails Heading to the S.E. Middle Part the Wind Bore to the Southward which being weather Heading to the Eastward Latter Part the same thick Rainy Weather No Dr

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Wednesday Sept 18 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Moderate Breeze from the South and thick Weather Heading to the Eastward Under Double Reefed main Top Sail and Stay Sails Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze from the Northward and Equally Steering to the Eastward Under Short Sail Breeze Put for Reef Lat 33.06 South Long 91.08 West

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Thursday Sept 19 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Light Breeze and Cloudy from the Northward Steering to the Eastward Under Short Sail at 8 P.M. took in Sail for the night Heading to the Eastward Middle and Latter Part Strong Breeze from the Southward and Cloudy Weather Steering to the S.E. Lat 32.55 South

of Falmouth on a Whaling Voyage in the South Atlantic Ocean

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Friday September 20 1839 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Strong Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy Weather Steering to the Eastward Under Short Sail Middle and Latter Part Strong Breeze from the S.W. Steering to the Eastward Under main Top Sail and Fore Sail Lat 32.40 South Long 29.26 West

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Saturday Sept 21 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Strong Gale from the S.W. and Equally Weather Steering to the Eastward Under main Top Sail and Fore Sail at 8 P.M. took in the Fore Sail and Luffed to the Wind to the S.E. Middle Part the same Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S.E. Under all Sail Saw Sun Backs at 1 P.M. lowered the Boats and Chased them Lat 32.41 South

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Sunday Sept 22 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Pleasant Weather Steering to the S.E. Under all Sail Saw Sun Backs at 8 P.M. took in Sail for the night Heading S.E. Middle Part the same Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy Made sail and Steered to the S.E. Lat 32.55 South Long 27.45 West

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Monday Sept 23 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy Weather Steering to the S.E. Under single Reefed Top Sails Saw Sun Backs at 8 P.M. Put the Under Mast Reef Main Top Sail and Stay Sails Bore Ship to the Northward Middle Part the same Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy at 7 P.M. Made sail and backed Ship to the S.E. Employed Making Ropes Lat 32.38 South

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Tuesday Sept 24 th Remarks Onboard
First Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy Weather Steering to the S.E. Under all Sail Employed Making Ropes Saw Sun Backs at 8 P.M. took in Sail for the night Heading S.E. Middle Part the same Latter Part Made sail and Steered to the S.E. With a Strong Breeze from the S.W. and Equally Employed Getting Out Oil for the Ship use Lat 32.35 South Long 27.16 West
