Tuesday October 15th 1839
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part moderate breeze from the S.W. and Pleasant weather steering to the S.W. Under all sail Employed at Ship's Duty at Sun set took in sail for the night heading S.W. Middle and Latter Part light Air from the South and Pleasant weather steering to the S.W. Employed getting Bread and Water Lat 35.14 South Long 24.14 West

Wednesday Oct 16th
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part Calm weather at 9 P.M. saw a sperm Whale going quick to the S.W. lowered the Boats and chased but with effect at Sun set same Onboard took in sail heading to the Westward Light Air from the Southward Middle and Latter Part Light breeze from the N.W. at Day light made all sail and steered to the S.W. at 8 A.M. saw a sperm Whale of the 4th beam kept ship off at 10 lowered the Boats but did not see the Whale at Meridian came Onboard and steered to the Southward Lat 35.11 South

Thursday Oct 17th
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part Strong breeze N.W. steering S.W. at 4 P.M. took in the main sail Topp and Spanker and put a Reef in Fore Top sail at 6 P.M. took in the Fore sail and lost Reef the main Top sail veered ship to the Southward Middle Part moderate breeze Latter Part a Gale S.W. heading N.W. Under lost Reef main Top sail and stay sail Lat 34.45 South

Friday Oct 18th
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part a Gale from the S.W. heading to the N.W. Under lost Reef main Top sail and stay sails Middle Part the same Latter Part Strong Gale S.W. veered ship to the Eastward Employed at Ship's Duty Lat 34.17 South

Saturday October 19th
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part moderate breeze S.W. steering to the Eastward Under double Reef at Sun set took in sail and veered ship to the Westward Middle Part light breeze from the Northward Latter Part the same at Day light made sail and steered to the S.W. Employed at Ship's Duty Lat 34.18 South Long 24.24 West

Sunday October 20th 1839
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part Strong breeze from the Northward and Pleasant weather steering to the S.W. Under all sail at 9 P.M. saw a ship at 5 P.M. spoke her it was the Delta of Green Past 9 mo. Out with no Oil at Sun set took sail heading West Middle Part the same Latter Part Strong breeze from the N.W. and Cloudy at Day light made sail and steered S.W. saw Black fish

Monday Oct 21st
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part Strong Gale N.W. and thick weather steering S.W. Under double Reef Top sails the Delta in sight at 6 P.M. took in the Fore sail and lost Top sail and lost Reef the Top sail suffered the wind to the Westward Rainy weather Middle and Latter Part the same at Day light set the Fore sail heading S.W.

Tuesday Oct 22nd
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part moderate breeze from the S.W. and Pleasant weather at 4 P.M. spoke the John and Elizabeth at Sun set took in sail heading to the N.W. Middle Part the same Latter Part Strong breeze from the Southward at Day light made sail at 9 A.M. backed ship to the S.W. saw ships in sight saw Fin Backs Lat 33.02 South Long 27.44 West

Wednesday Oct 23rd
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part Strong breeze from the Southward steering to the S.W. Under all sail at 4 P.M. backed ship to the S.W. saw Fin Backs and perceived one ship in sight off the Lee at 6 P.M. took in sail for the night heading S.W. Middle Part the same Latter Part Strong breeze from the Southward at Day light made all sail steering S.W. at 10 A.M. blowing Strong set her Under double Reef main Top sail and Fore sail Employed getting Out Boat Lat 33.17 South Long 27.44 West

Thursday Oct 24th
 Remarks Onboard
 First Part Strong Gale from the Southward and Cloudy heading S.W. at 8 P.M. took in the Fore sail and lost Reef the main Top sail one ship in sight Middle and Latter Part Strong Gale from S.W. and thick Rainy weather heading South
