Saturday Dec 14th 1839 ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Breeze from the northward
Employed Boiling and Sailing at 5 P.M. finished Sailing at Sun
Set took in Sail heading to the Westward. Weather Clear
Middle Part Strong Breeze from the Northward heading to the
Westward Employed Boiling at 5 A.M. finished Boiling Saturday
Strong Gale from the North heading to the West Employed Stowing down
Two Bright Whales did not lower

Sunday Dec 15th ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Strong Gale from the Northward and strong
Weather heading to the Westward Employed Stowing down Oil in
Part Strong Breeze from the Southward with some rain heading to
the Eastward Latter Part the same finished Stowing down Oil and
Down Ship and Steered N.W. Lat 36.21 South Long 26.11 West

Monday Dec 16th ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Strong Breeze from the Southward with
some squalls of Rain Steering N.W. two ships in sight saw a Right
Whale going quick did not lower the Boats put a Man in the Hugging
and struck him 6 times for striking the Capt at Sun Set took in sail for
the night and luffed to the Wind to the Westward Middle Part the same
Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. and Pleasant Weather at
Day Light made sail and Steered N.W. at 10 A.M. spoke the Barque
Hable & me Out 400 fath Oil saw him Backs Lat 35.39 South

Tuesday Dec 17th ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Light Breeze from the Eastward and
Pleasant Weather Steering to the Northward Under all sail at Sunset
took in sail heading North Middle and Latter Part Moderate Breeze
from the S.W. and Pleasant Weather at Day Light made all
sail and Steered to the N.W. in company with the Barque
Hable saw him Backs Lat 35.59 South Long 26.36 West

Op. Halmouth On a Whaling Voyage in the South Atlantic

Wednesday December 18th 1839 ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Light Breeze from the Eastward and
Pleasant Weather Steering S.W. in company with the Barque Hable at
Sun Set took in sail for the night heading to the Eastward Middle Part
the same Latter Part Moderate Breeze at Day Light made sail and
Steered to the S.W. Employed about Ships Sails started a cask of Water
Lat 35.42 South Long 27.07 West

Thursday Dec 19th ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Moderate Breeze from the Eastward and
Pleasant Weather Steering S.W. Under all sail Employed at 8 o'clock
at Sun Set took in sail and luffed to the Wind to the
S.W. Middle Part the same Latter Part Moderate Breeze from the S.W. at Day
Light made all sail and Steered S.W. saw a Ship at meridian saw Right
Whales got Ready to lower Lat 36.11 South Long 27.04 West

Friday Dec 20th ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Breeze from the S.W. Steering to the East
Lower for the above mentioned Whales did not lower came Onboard and
to the S.W. and South End Ship in sight at Sun Set took in sail and
Down Ship to the S.W. Middle and Latter Part Strong Breeze from the
Northward and Thick Weather at Day Light made sail and Steered West
Lat 36.49 South Long 27.04 West

Saturday Dec 21st ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Strong Breeze from the North
and Thick Weather Steering West at Sun Set took in sail and luffed
to the Wind to the S.W. Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze and
Thick Weather at Day Light made sail Steered to the Westward Thick
Breeze weather took in sail Lat 37.23 South Long 29.53 West

Sunday Dec 22nd ✖ Remarks Onboard

First Part Light Breeze from the Northward and
Thick Weather up sail Steered to the West at 6 P.M. took in sail
Thick foggy weather heading N.W. Middle and Latter Part Breeze
from the Northward and Thick Weather Steering to the
Eastward saw Killas Lat 37.25 South Long 30.23 West
