Out 3 Whales Middle Part moderate Breeze from the Northward and Thick Raining Weather Steering to the S.W. at Day Light Made sail and veered ship to the North Moderate Breeze from the Westward Steered S.W. Employed Repairing a Jib sail and other sails One Man Down with the Scurvy and Other Complaining He Shall make the Best of Our Way for Wednesday Lat 37.16 South Long 31.50 West

 First Part Calm Weather Employed Repairing the main Jib sail Bent the Main Top Gallant sail Middle Part Calm Weather Latter Part Light Breeze from the S.W. Steering by the Wind to the S.W. Employed Repairing the Main Top sail Lat 36.40 South Long 31.10 West

Saturday Dec 28 **Remarks Onboard**
 First Part Thick Breeze from the Northward and Thick Weather Steering to the Westward by the Wind Employed Repairing the Main Top sail Middle and Latter Part Strong Breeze from the North and Smokey took in the Main Top Gallant sail and set one Reef in the Fore Top sail at 11 A.M. Tackled ship to the S.E. Hoisted one of the Fore Top Mast Backstay Strained Put a Tackle on Lat 36.07 South Long 34.02 West

Sunday Dec 29 **Remarks Onboard**
 First Part Strong Breeze from the Northward and Smokey Steering by the Wind to the S.E. Put a butting Tack on for Fore Top Mast Backstay Middle and Latter Part Strong Gale from the Northward and Raining Weather Steering S.E. Under Double Reef Top sails Lat South Long West

Monday 30 Dec **Remarks Onboard**
 First Part Strong Gale from the Northward and Raining Weather at 2 P.M. veered ship to the S.W. at 4 P.M. put her close reefed Main Top sail and stay sails at 6 P.M. veered ship to the S.E. Bloating and Raining Weather Middle and Latter Part moderate Breeze from the Southward and Thick Raining Weather at 1 A.M. on kept off North and set the Fore sail at 4 A.M. Made all sail Heavy North Thick Raining Weather

Tuesday Dec 31 **Remarks Onboard**
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the Southward and Thick Raining Weather Steering North Under all sail Middle Part Light Air from S.E. and Thick Raining Weather Latter Part Strong Gale from the S.E. and Thick Raining Weather Steering North Under Double Reef Top sails Bent the Main Top sail six took in the Mast Boat Steering North to end this Year
