Tuesday Jan 7th
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the S. S. E. and Pleasant Weather steering by the Wind heading East Employed Repairing the Main Sail and Other Sails about the Ship Middle Part the same Latter Part the Wind veered to the Eastward Made Ship to the South Employed Repairing the Main Sail Lat 25.17 South Long 31.49 West

Wednesday Jan 8th
 First Part Moderate Breeze from the Eastward and Pleasant Weather steering by the Wind to the North finished the Main Sail and Bent it Middle and Latter Moderate Breeze from the Eastward and Pleasant Weather steering by the Wind to the N. N. E. Bent the Top Sail Lat 24.14 South Long 31.51 West

Thursday Jan 9th

Friday Jan 10th
