First Part Light Breeze from N. E. and Pleasant Weather steering N. W. Employed painting Middle Part variable winds and squally, Rainy weather set the top Gallant sails and top Mast standing sail Latter Part Light Breeze S. E. and fair weather steering N. W. Employed at ship's duty Lat 19.21 North Long 54.19 West

Wednesday Feb 12<sup>th</sup> *Remarks Onboard*

First Part Light Breeze S. E. and Pleasant Weather steering N. W. Under all sail Middle and Latter Part Light Breeze from the S. E. and Pleasant Weather steering N. W. Employed at ship's duty started a bark of Flour Lat 19.59 North Long 54.29 West

W. took in the top Gallant sail and reefed the fore top sail Latter Moderate Breeze from the Eastward made all sail Lat 21.11 North 58.45 West
