

Sunday 5th first part of these 24 hours light winds and good weather Middle and latter part strong winds Doubled reefed the topsails fore and aft

Monday 6th these twenty four hours strong winds and heavy sea under double reefed topsails nothing in sight

Tuesday 7th these twenty four hours light breeze and good weather a dead whale in sight latter part strong breeze reefed the topsails

Wednesday 8th this day light winds and good weather shook out the reef and set the top gallant sail so goes

Thursday 9th first part of these 24 hours light breeze shook out the reef out of the topsails latter part squally reefed the topsails

Wednesday 10th these twenty four hours strong breeze and good weather all hands employed in ship duty, nothing in sight

Thursday 11th this day fresh winds and good weather nothing in sight so goes &c.

Friday 12th this day strong breeze and good weather steering before the wind at sunset half on the wind.

Saturday 13th these twenty four hours moderate winds and good weather fine flocks in sight &c.

Sunday 14th first part of these 24 hours fresh breeze and good weather running free set top gallant sails fine flocks in sight Middle and latter part

Sunday 15th this day strong winds and good weather nothing in sight so goes

Monday 16th first part of these 24 hours good weather Middle and latter part specially with rain double reefed the topsails so ends this day

Tuesday 17th these twenty four hours strong breeze and good weather latter part reefed the topsails.

Wednesday 18th this day strong breeze and good weather at 8 P.M. two whales covered but did not fasten a ship in sight so quit the line with us.

Thursday 19th this day good weather and strong breeze nothing in sight

Friday 20th this day fine weather a big in sight

Saturday 21th this day fine weather and fresh breeze fine in sight and a carcass

Sunday 22th this day strong breeze and squally three ships in sight

Monday 23th these twenty four hours strong breeze and good weather two ships and whales in sight

Tuesday 24th first part of the 24 hours squally with rain at 2 P.M. double reefed the topsails split the jib on the t and beat a new one and mended the old one 2 ships in sight

Wednesday 25th this day strong winds and good weather nothing more remarkable
