Monday 29th this day fresh breeze and good weather 2 ships in sight.

Tuesday 30th this day light winds and good weather all hands employed in stowing down oil at 4 P.M. got done and washed off decks Sat 4th 5th 6th 7th 8th 9th 10th 11th 12th 13th 14th 15th 16th 17th 18th 19th 20th 21th 22th 23th 24th 25th 26th 27th 28th 29th 30th 31st

Wednesday 31st these 24 hours strong winds and good weather 2 ships in sight to the leeward.

Friday 2nd this day strong breeze and good weather three ships in sight at 6 P.M. spoke the Hebrides Hudson

Capt. Cottle 34 mo out 26000 nothing more remarkable.

Saturday 3rd these twenty four hours strong breeze and good weather nothing more worth mentioning.

Sunday 4th this day fresh breeze and good weather ships in sight nothing more worth mentioning so goes this day.

Monday 5th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather 2 ships in sight so goes.

Tuesday 6th this day strong winds and good weather 2 ships in sight to the leeward.

Wednesday 7th first part of these 24 hours fresh breeze and good weather so goes.

Thursday 8th this day strong breeze and good weather at 5 P.M. spoke the ship catwaba of Hancock Capt. Coleman 9 mo out 12000.

Friday 9th this day strong breeze and good weather all sail set ships in sight to the leeward so ends.

Saturday 10th this day strong breeze and good weather two ships in sight.

Sunday 11th these 24 hours strong winds and good weather at 4 P.M. spoke the ship Timoleon New Bedford Capt. Bunker 11 mo out 15000.

Monday 12th first part of these 24 hours 1 ship in sight and a great number of finbacks nothing more remarkable.
