

Fryday 18th this day strong breeze and good weather all hands employed in storming down in the after hold at 4 P.M. got done &c.

Saturday 19th this day strong breeze and good weather &c.

Sunday 20th these twenty four strong breeze and good weather nothing in sight.

Monday 21st this day strong breeze and a heavy sea at 6 P.M. see whales going to the windward but did not lower.

Tuesday 22nd this day strong breeze and good weather at 2 O'clock P.M. see whales going to the windward at 3 lowered but did not fasten.

Wednesday 23rd this day strong wind and good weather see whales. Harbored boat fastened the bow boat pulled up and fastened and cut off the masts line the bow boat drawn and lost the whale.

Thursday 24th this day strong wind and good weather see whales in the morning goin to the windward at 4 P.M. see whales again lowered chased till dark got none &c.

Fryday 25th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather hands employed in fitting a new sling to the fore yard &c so ends this day.

Saturday 26th this day strong breeze and fine weather at 8 A.M. see whales going to the windward at 1 P.M. break out for water in the ^{last} haul.

Sunday 27th these 24 hours strong breeze with a heavy sea at half past 4 see a ship off the head bow & boiling at 10 O.M. see whales at half past 12 lowered got nothing came on board at 4 P.M. lowered & again got nothing at 6 P.M. spoke the ship Augusta New Bedford Capt Lawrence 28 men and 17000 lbs and 500 whales.

Monday 28th this day strong breeze and good weather a ship in sight to the leeward so ends this day.

Tuesday 29th this day moderate breeze and good weather at 4 P.M. spoke the ship Augusta New Bedford Capt Lawrence 17500 lbs sperm oil.

Wednesday 30th this day strong breeze and good weather first part the ship Augusta in sight to the leeward.

Thursday Dec 1st this day moderate breeze and fine weather first part on bent the foresail and mended and bent it.

Fryday 2nd this day strong breeze and fine weather on bent the main sail and mended and bent it again.

Saturday 3rd these 24 hours moderate breeze and fine weather at 8 O'clock lowered for four which made as 14000 lbs. 2 to the 1 Boat and 1 to the bow along side and got them in and began to boil out.
