

Thursday 4th this day strong breeze and good weather hands employed in cutting in boiling at half past 7 lowered for whale got to the larboard boat which made 35 lbs of oil

Monday 5th this day strong breeze and good weather hands employed in boiling out oil first part see whales but did not lower so goes

Tuesday 6th these 24 hours light wind and good weather hands employed in boiling out oil see whale lowered got nothing so goes the times with us

Wednesday 7th this day fresh breeze and fine weather hands employed in boiling at noon got done.

Thursday 8th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather hands employed in setting up shoos so ends this day.

Friday 9th this day strong wind and good weather all hands employed in breaking out and storing down oil in the after hold a ship in sight

Saturday 10th this day strong breeze and good weather all hands employed in storing down oil at 12 see whale lowered got to the waste boat which made us 25 lbs took him along side and finished storing cut him in and began to boil out

Sunday 11th this day strong breeze and good weather hands employed in boiling at 6 P.M. got done see whale got to the starboard boat which made us 6 lbs took him along side and lay by him all night

Monday 12th this day strong breeze and good weather at half past 5 began to cut in at 7 A.M. began to boil out at 8 P.M. got done

Tuesday 13th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather hands employed in mending the fore top mast stowsail and bent it at 4 P.M. bent the main top gallant sail and bent a new one at 5 P.M. set the fore and mizen top gallant sails and fly jib. a ship in sight off the larboard

Wednesday 14th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather steering to the S and E with all sail set Lat 6° 13' S.

Thursday 15th this day strong breeze and good weather all hands employed in mending sails steering to the S and E Lat 12° 35' S.

Friday 16th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather steering to the S and E nothing more remarkable Lat 12° 21' S.

Saturday 17th these 24 hours strong winds and good weather steering to the Southward Lat 16° 35' S.

Sunday 18th first part of this day strong winds latter part light wind steering to the S and Eastward with all sail set Lat 17° 4' S.

Monday 19th this day begins with squally and rainy weather middle and latter part pleasant so ends Lat 19° 21' S. Long 115° 26' W.

Tuesday 20th this day comes with moderate breeze and pleasant and ends the same Lat 21° 21' S.
