Tuesday 31st this day strong breeze and good weather at 12 o'clock spoke the Charles of London Capt. Hammond.

Wednesday Feb 1st 1836. this day strong breeze and good weather nothing in sight so end this day.

Thursday 2^d this day strong breeze and good weather hand employed in ship duty.

Friday 3^d these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather so end this day.

Saturday 4th these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather at sun set squared the yards and stood to the Northward Lat 9° 9' N

Saturday 5th this day strong breeze and fine weather Lat 9° 45' N.

Monday 6th this day fine weather at 6 A.M. made the land distant about 30 miles steering S. N. E. middle part the same at 4 P.M. spoke a brig bound to Calcutta latter part steering S. Lat 7° 12'

Tuesday 7th Light winds and pleasant payta Head at 6 A.M. about 20 miles distant at 11 A.M. came to anchor in payta harbor.

Wednesday 8th this day fine weather laying at anchor in payta harbor of Washington Sanketkit 7 months out 2500 lb the General Jackson Bristol R.I. 6 months out 2500 lb

Thursday 9th this day fine weather

Friday 10th this day fine weather hand employed in getting off potatoes and onions &c.

Saturday 11th this day fine weather so end

Sunday 12th this day pleasant &c

Monday 13th this day fine weather at 7 A.M. the ship Logan came to anchor 32 months out 18500 lb

Tuesday 14th this day fine weather the ship Timoleon lying off and at payta 6000 lb the ganges lying off and on so end this day.

Wednesday 15th this day fine weather

Thursday 16th this day fine weather the Orion Sanketkit came to anchor 6 months out 500 lb so end

Friday 17th this day pleasant four of our men left so gives the time

Saturday 18th this day good weather hand employed in paint the bend so end this day

Sunday 19th this day fine weather shipped three men
