

Friday 19th the first part of this day strong winds and rainy later part fine weather so ends this day. at 12 o'clock spoke the William Penn of Balmouth capt. Bodfish 7 mo out 1000 lbs so ends this day

Saturday 20th these 24 hours rainy and fresh breeze and so ends this day at 6 P.M. took in the top.

Sunday 21st these 24 hours squally with rain at 2 P.M. doubled reefed the top sails so ends

Monday 22^d this day fresh winds and good weather land about 10 miles distant so ends. Lat 2° 8' N

Tuesday 23^d this day strong winds and good weather a ship in

Wednesday 24th these 24 hours strong wind and good weather in sight of land.

Thursday 25th this day strong wind steering in shore with all set at 4 P.M. Came to anchor in Tacamas harbour ships lying at anchor Robert Edward New Bedford 21 mo out 1800 lbs. Francis of Do Capt Christian 18 months out 1000 lbs William Penn Balmouth capt Bodfish 7 mo out 1000 lbs. Ocean of Pan ticket capt Parker 12 mo out 600 lbs. the panatmar of Sag Harbor capt Lane 21 mo out 5000 lbs 2900 whale 1000 sperm so ends.

Monday June 5th 1837.

Clear and pleasant first part got under way and stood out to sea see a ship standing in to the N.

Tuesday 6th this day strong winds and good weather first part see whales lowered took one to the S boat took him along side and cut him in and began to haul out

Wednesday 7th this day strong winds and fine weather at 11 A.M. got done hauling so ends this day.

Thursday 8th this day strong winds and good weather nothing in sight

Friday 9th these 24 hours strong breeze and fine weather nothing more remarkable so ends this day.

Saturday 10th this day strong winds and good weather steering to the Westward Lat 4° 15' N.

Sunday 11th these 24 hours strong wind and fine weather at 5 P.M. passed two ships one to the leeward the other to the windward so ends this day.

Monday 12th this day fine weather with a fresh wind so ends this day

Tuesday 13th these 24 hours fresh winds and good first part made the Abington Island Nothing in sight

Wednesday 14th these 24 hours fresh winds and good weather land in sight so ends this day
