standing to the Southward.

March 4th this day light winds
and cloudy latter part
rainy so ends this day.

March 5th this day light winds
and fine weather so ends this day

March 6th this day light winds and
fine weather all hands employed
in fitting rigging so ends this day

March 7th these 24 hours light winds
and fine weather all hands
employed in fitting rigging
so ends this day Lat 1.33 S

March 8th these 24 hours light winds
and fine weather hands employed
in fitting rigging Lat 1.33 S

March 9th this day light winds and
fine weather one of the Galla
pagos Islands in sight so ends this
day course S.W.

March 10th these 24 hours light winds and
fine weather hands employed in
ship duty Charles Island in
sight so ends this day

March 11th this day light winds and
good weather Charles about 25
miles distant so ends this day.

March 12th these 24 hours light winds
and fine weather nothing in
sight Lat 1.42 S

March 13th this day light winds and
fine weather two ships in
sight at 7 P.M. spoke the
Ship William and Eliza New
Bedford Capt Colling 31 months
out 10000 so ends this day.

March 14th this day light winds and
fine weather steering S.W.
two ships in sight to the seaward
Lat 2.36 S

March 15th this day light winds
and fine weather steering S.W.
at 7 P.M. spoke the ship
Spartan Starlinket Capt Coffin
29 months out 11000 2 frem
whales in sight so ends this
Lat 3.00 S
