

June 13th 1838
 These twenty four hours
 light winds and fine weather
 their steering E. S. E. hand
 employed in fitting studi-
 ing sails at 2 P. M. set
 the fore topmast studding-
 sail nothing more remar-
 kable. Lat 29° 21' S

June 14th This day light wind
 from the N. W. steering
 E. S. E. first set the fore
 and main top gallant s-
 tudding sails middle and
 latter part the same
 so ends this day Lat 30° 25' S

June 15th first part of these
 24 hours strong winds and
 fine weather steering
 E. S. E. winds from the
 N. N. W. middle part
 from the W. latter part
 from the S. W. with rain
 at 1 P. M. set the top
 gallant studding sails at
 6 P. M. took in the studding
 sails and fore and main
 top gallant sails so ends
 this day Lat 31° 36' S

June 16th these 24 hours strong
 winds from the N. N. W.
 to S. W. steering E. S. E. with
 all sail set at 4 P. M.
 halled in the fore topmast
 studding sail also the fore
 and main top gallant sails
 first part took in the
 Bow and Waste Boats
 Lat 33° 02' S

June 17th 1838
 these 24 hours light winds and
 cloudy winds from N. N. W. to
 S. W. steering E. S. E. with all
 sail set so ends this day
 heavy sea setting from the W
 Lat 34° 15' S

June 18th these 24 hours fresh winds
 from the N. N. W. steering
 E. S. E. first part set
 all sail middle part the same
 at 6 P. M. took in the top
 gallant studding sails so ends
 this day Long 102° 00' W Lat 35° 14' S

June 19th these 24 hours fresh gales and
 and squally winds from the N.
 steering E. S. E. Middle and latter
 part raining the same so ends this
 day

June 20th these 24 hours and fine strong
 winds and squally middle and
 latter part raining winds from
 the N. steering E. S. E. latter part
 took in the top gallant sails
 doubled reefed the top sails furled
 the mainmast and stowed the
 gear so ends Lat 37° 01' S

June 21st first part of these 24 hours
 moderate breeze and squally
 first part shook the reefs
 out of the top sails set the
 top gallant sails also the main
 sail winds from the W. steering
 E. S. E. Lat 41° 43' S

June 22nd
 first part of these 24 hours strong
 winds from the N. steering
 E. S. E. Middle part the same
 at 4 P. M. halled the top gall-
 ant sails at 6 set them again Lat 43° 48' S
