

Journal of A Voyage On Board the Ship

Tuesday Dec 11 th	First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze and cloudy at 4 P.M. fresh gales from the N.W. steering S.E. Double reefed the topsails, middle part rainy latter part very light winds so ends Lat by Obs 36° 27' N. Long by Chro 44° 04' W.
Wednesday Dec 12 th	All these 24 hours fresh breeze and cloudy at half past 7 saw two sperm whales lowered got none first part steering E by S latter part E S E.
Thursday Dec 13 th	First part of this day strong gales from the S furled the fore and main topsails, and close reefed the main middle part the same latter part wind halled round to the Northward so ends these 24 hours
Friday Dec 14 th	First part of these 24 hours strong gales from the Northward steering E S E under double reefed topsails and fore sail middle and latter part the same Lat by Obs 35° 20' N. Long by Chronometer 54° 44' W.
Saturday Dec 15 th	First part of this day fresh gales and foggy steering E S E middle part wind halled to the S and Eastward steering by the wind with the starboard tack I board latter part the same Lat by Obs 34° 40' N.
Sunday Dec 16 th	First part of this day strong winds from the S middle part winds from the South and Eastward. latter part from the Southward under double reefed topsails so ends this day Long by Chronometer 48° 06' W. Lat by Obs 34° 51' N. Long by Chro 48° 03' W.

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Monday Dec 17 th	First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S. S. E. steering by the wind with the starboard tack I board middle and latter part winds from the S. S. W. steering E by S. Lat by Obs 34° 37' N. Long by Chro 44° 04' W.
Tuesday Dec 18 th	All these 24 hours strong winds from the S S W steering E S E with fine weather halled employed in ship duty Lat by Obs 32° 31' N. Long by Chro 40° 55' W.
Wednesday Dec 19 th	First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the S.W. and fine weather middle part wind from the W S W and squally with rain latter part the wind from the S W and cloudy steering S E Long by Chro 39° 15' W. Lat by Obs 31° 41' N.
Thursday Dec 20 th	First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the S W and fine weather middle part light squalls latter part fine breeze from the S. S. W. steering S E riced out the flying jill boom Long by Chro 38° 59' W. Lat 30° 38' N.
Friday Dec 21 th	These 24 hours strong winds from the S and westward and fine weather steering S E with all sail set. Long by Chro 32° 55' W. Lat by Obs 30° 55' N.
Thursday Dec 22 th	First part of this day fresh winds from the S W steering S E middle part light winds with rain wind from the S and Eastward steering by the wind with the starboard tack I board latter part the same Long by Chro 31° 31' W. Lat by Obs 31° 21' N.
