1837.

Jan 12th These 24 hours strong wind and
Friday cloudy wind from the S.E. steering
by the wind with the larboard
tacks a board. 1 ship in sight
Lat by Obs 00° 59' N
Long by Chro 20° 44' W

Sunday All these 24 hours strong wind and fine
Jan 13th weather wind from the S.E. steering
S.W. by W. first part 1 ship in
sight latter part a brig.
Lat by Obs 1° 51' S
Long by Chro 22° 13' W

Monday All these 24 hours strong wind and
Jan 14th fine weather wind from the S.E.
steering by the wind with the larboard
tacks on board a Brig in sight
steering to the S and W so end
Lat by Obs 4° 08' S
Long by Chro 23° 37' W

Tuesday First part of this day strong wind
Jan 15th from the South and Eastward a
Brig in sight middle and latter
part the same. steering by the
wind with the larboard tacks a board
a ship in sight to the windward
Lat by Obs 6° 23' S
Long by Chro 24° 30' W

Wednesday All these 24 hours strong breeze
Jan 16th and fine weather first part steering
S.W. by W. middle and latter part
S by W. first part two ships
in sight employed in rattling
down the rigging so end.
Lat by Obs 8° 54' S
Long by Chro 24° 54' 30" W

Thursday All these 24 hours strong wind and
Jan 17th fine weather wind from the S.E.
steering by the wind with the larboard
tacks on board so end this 24 hours
Lat by Obs 11° 25' S Long by Chro 25° 06' 30" W

Friday All this day strong wind from the S.E.
Jan 18th and good weather steering by the wind
with all sail set so end
Lat by Obs 13° 57' S
Long by Chro 25° 24' 30" W

Saturday All these 24 hours strong wind and
Jan 19th day with squalls steering by the wind
with all sail set so end.
Long by Loner 25° 20' W Lat by Obs 16° 31' S

Sunday First part of this day strong wind
Jan 20th and cloudy steering S. latter part
strong wind and squalls so end this
at 4 P.M. we made the longitude
by Loner Distance 28° 10' 15" W
Lat by Obs 00

Monday All these 24 hours fresh breeze and
Jan 21st cloudy wind from the Eastward steering
S. by E. nothing more remarkable
Long by Loner 27° 15' W Lat by Obs 20° 53' S

Tuesday All these 24 hours fresh breeze and
Jan 22nd fine weather steering S.E. by E.
wind from the S and East ward
two ships in sight so end
Lat by Obs 22° 33' S
Long by Loner Dist P.M. 27° 39' 15" W

All this day fresh breeze from the
South ward steering S.E. at 4 P.M.
spoke the Barke Jane Brown
Liverpool 62 days from Valparaiso
