

Bound to Liverpool so ends this Day
Lat by obs $23^{\circ} 39' N$
Long by lunar Dist $25^{\circ} 11' W$

Thursday
Jan 24th First part of this Day fresh breeze
and cloudy middle part squally
with rain latter part good weather
winds varying ESE to S
steering SSE . Lat by obs $24^{\circ} 40' N$

Friday
Jan 25th First part of these 24 hours light winds
from the SE steering SE latter
part the same Lat by obs
Long by lunar Dist $21^{\circ} 23' W$

Saturday
Jan 26th First part of these 24 hours light
winds from the S and E steering
 SE by S at 4 P M wind halled
round to the S and westward at
4 P M wind halled to the South
ward at 7 P M we saw whales lower
got 5 one to the Starboard one
to the Larboard 2 to the waste and
one to the Bow Boat latter part
a brig in sight so ends this Day
Lat by obs $25^{\circ} 56' N$
Long by lunar $21^{\circ} 23' W$

Sunday
Jan 27th

All these 24 hours strong winds and
fine weather first part got the
whales along side and began
to cut in steering by the wind

Monday
Jan 28th All these 24 hours strong winds
and fine weather winds from the
Eastward steering by the wind
at 8 P M began to boil.

Tuesday
Jan 29th These 24 hours light winds and good
weather hands employed in boiling
out oil, winds from the Eastward
steering by the wind with the lar-
board tacks a board. Lat $26^{\circ} 15' N$
Long by chro $21^{\circ} 30' W$

Wednesday
Jan 30th These 24 hours, light winds and good
weather at 2 P M wore ship and
stood on the wind with the starboard
tacks on board heading to the East-
ward first part spoke a brig from
London bound to St Helena latter
part got done boiling.
Lat by obs $27^{\circ} 39' N$
Long by chro $22^{\circ} 01' W$

Thursday
Jan 31st All these 24 hours light breeze and
fine weather steering by the wind with
the Larboard tacks on board latter
part employed in striking the oil
down between decks at 10 P M
saw a ship to the leeward.
Lat $27^{\circ} 56' N$
Long by chro $21^{\circ} 18' W$

Friday
Jan 1st All this Day light winds and fine
weather steering by the wind at 3
P M tacked ship and stood on the
wind heading to S and westward
Lat by obs $28^{\circ} 14' N$
Long by chro $20^{\circ} 51' 30' W$

Saturday
Feb 2nd These 24 hours light winds and fine
weather steering by the wind with
the Larboard tacks a board, variable
winds from the Eastward at 7 P M
saw a whale but did not follow so
ends this Day Lat by obs
Long by lunar Dist $16^{\circ} 23' W$
Lat by obs $29^{\circ} 56' N$
