Sunday Feb 3<sup>rd</sup> First part of these 24 hours light breeze from the Eastward from 4 to 8 calm & to 12 light breeze from 12 to 4 light breeze and latter part the same so ends  
Lat by Obs 29° 18' N  
Long by Lunar Dist 16 25 W

Monday Feb 4<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours fresh breeze and fine weather winds from the N steering S. E. so ends.  
Lat by obs 30° 22' N  
Long by Obs 17° 30' W

Tuesday Feb 5<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours fresh breeze and fine weather, winds from the N and westward steering S. E. by E so ends.  
Lat by Obs 31° 32' N  
Long by Lunar Dist 15° 00' W

Wednesday Feb 6<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours fresh breeze and fine weather winds from the North ward steering S. E. so ends.  
Lat by obs 33° 11' N  
Long by Lunar Dist 14° 31' W

Thursday Feb 7<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours fresh breeze and fine weather winds from the North and westward steering S. E. so ends.  
Lat by Obs 34° 46' N

Friday Feb 8<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours strong breeze varying from the N. N. W. to S. S. E. first part steering S by E at 2 A.M. halled her up S. E. at 5 halled up E. S. E. first part good weather middle and latter part foggy -

Saturday Feb 9<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours strong winds from the Southward and cloudy steering by the wind with the Starboard tacks a board  
Lat by Obs 35° 24' N  
Long by Lunar at 9 A.M. 8° 43' 30" W

Sunday Feb 10<sup>th</sup> These 24 hours strong wind and cloudy winds from the Southward steering by the wind with the Starboard tacks a board, a ship in sight to the leeward  
Lat by Obs 34° 30' N  
Long by Lunar at 2 P.M. 5° 18' 30" W  
Long by Lunar at 10 A.M. 7° 26' 00" W

Monday Feb 11<sup>th</sup> First part of this day moderate breeze and cloudy, a ship in sight middle and latter part a very light breeze from the N and Eastward  
Lat 35° 21' N

Tuesday Feb 12<sup>th</sup> First part of this day a light air from the N and East ward steering E by N middle and latter part wind from the N and Westward so ends this day  
Lat by obs 35° 25' N

Wednesday Feb 13<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours moderate breeze and cloudy winds from the Northward steering S. E. by E a ship in sight  
Lat 35° 45' N  
Long by Obs 00° 40' W

Thursday Feb 14<sup>th</sup> first part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the N N E steering S. E. by E middle and latter part strong winds at 6 A.M. took in the topgallant masts at noon double reefed the topsails so ends this day

Long by Obs 10° 43' W
