

Saturday
May 11th

First part of this day fresh breeze from the S W and cloudy middle and latter part the same. at 1/2 past one see whales lowered and got one to the larboard Boat took him along side and lay by him all night. at 6 A.M. began to cut so ends this day
Lat by Obs 32° 27' S. Long 178° 21' W

Sunday
May 12th

These 24 hours strong winds and cloudy with squalls. at 3 P.M. finished cutting and began to bail. middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat by Obs 31° 51' S. Long 179° 17' W

Monday
May 13th

These 24 hours moderate winds from the W at 6 P.M. took in sail for the night at 6 A.M. made sail. hands employed in stowing down oil in the main hatch way

Lat by Obs 31° 45' S

Tuesday
May 14th

First part of these 24 hours moderate breeze and cloudy at 6 P.M. shortened sail as usual at 6 A.M. made sail again. wind from the S W steering S E so ends these 24 hours

Lat by Obs 31° 57' S

Wednesday
May 15th

All these 24 hours fresh breeze from the S W and cloudy. steering E at 6 took in sail at 6 P.M. made sail again so ends these 24 hours

Lat by Obs 31° 41' S

Thursday
May 16th

These 24 hours comes with moderate breeze from the S E and fair weather steering N E saw a large whale one rising and saw nothing more of him at 10 A.M. saw French Rock bearing W of W so ends this day
Lat by Obs 31° 17' S

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Friday
May 17th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes and squalls. middle and latter part good weather. first part steering S by E, wind from the E S E. at 3 P.M. made got Island bearing S by E run till 5 P.M. took in sail, and lay by heading to the S. at 2 A.M. wore ship heading S E by S. at 6 took land bore E S E made sail and stood on the wind heading S E by S.

Lat by Obs 30° 17' S

Saturday
May 18th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the Eastward, and good weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack on board at half past 5 made Sunday Island bearing S by E, at 6 P.M. got Island bore S E from us, at 6 A.M. tacked ship and stood in for the land at 9 A.M. tacked ship heading S by E meridian land bore S E. Lat by Obs 28° 56' Long by Chron 178° 26' W.

Sunday
May 19th

These 24 hours comes with light breeze and fine weather steering by the wind. the wind from the S E at 8 P.M. took in the main sail and topgallant sails land bearing from us S by W at 6 A.M. see whales to the larboard bound to the windward lowered did not fasten, set all sail and stood after them so ends this day.

Lat by Obs 29° W. S

Monday
May 20th

These 24 hours fresh breeze from the S and cloudy at 6 P.M. took in sail for the night land bearing from us S W at midnight wore ship at 6 A.M. wore ship and made sail
