

Tuesday
May 21st
These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the W & W and cloudy at 6 P.M. took in sail for the knight, middle and latter part squally at 6 A.M. cept off W & E
Lat by Obs 28° 54' N

Wednesday
May 22nd
This day comes with strong winds from the W & E, and squally steering S & E, middle and latter part the same so ends this day
Lat by Obs 26° 55' N

Thursday
May 23rd
These 24 hours comes with strong winds and cloudy steering S by E, winds from the W & W first part on bent and bent the fore sail, at dark took in sail as usual, steering S by E at midnight the wind halled to the Westward at 7 A.M. see two large whales, lowered two Boats But did not fasten, came on Board at 10 A.M. lowered again got nothing
Lat by Obs 25° 51' N

Friday
May 24th
These 24 hours commences with strong winds from the W and squally with rain middle part light gale, at midnight more ship heading to the W first part two large whales in sight it come on to blow so heavy we could do nothing at daylight set the fore and main topsails close reefed heading W by N at meridian more ship heading S by E
Lat by Obs 25° 35' N

Saturday
May 25th
all these 24 hours strong winds from the W and cloudy at 6 P.M. took in sail at daylight made sail again, and more ship at noon wore ship again
Lat 25° 45' N Long 173° 51' W

Sunday
May 26th
All these 24 hours light winds from the W with rain, first part steering by the wind at 6 P.M. took in sail and cept off S by E at 3 A.M. see a ship we hall it on the wind at 8 A.M. spoke the John Adair's Kankuckat capt. Coleman 18 mo out with 5000, with a whale along side
Lat by Obs 25° 15' N
Long 173° 30' W

Monday
May 27th
First part of these 24 hours light winds and cloudy, a ship in sight at 6 P.M. took in sail for the knight at day light made sail again, middle and latter part strong winds so ends
Lat by Obs 25° 17' N
Long 173° 49' W

Tuesday
May 28th
First and middle part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the south and cloudy latter part good weather a ship in sight so ends this day
Lat by Obs 24° 48' N
Long 173° 25' W

Wednesday
May 29th
First part of this day fresh breeze and fine weather, wind from the W & E steering S at sunset took in sail at daylight made sail as usual, middle and latter part the same
Lat by Obs 23° 44' N
Long 173° 26' W

Thursday
May 30th
First and middle part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the W & E and fine weather, latter part squally so ends
Lat by Obs 22° 10' N

Friday
May 31st
These 24 hours fresh breeze from the W & E and cloudy, at 2 P.M. see a large breach, cept the ship for it but see it no more at dark took in sail at daylight made sail again steering S by E so ends lat.
