

Saturday
June 1st First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze and fine weather, wind from the E & E middle and latter part squally with rain

Sunday
June 2nd First part of these 24 hours strong wind from the E & E and cloudy steering S by W at Dark took in sail at midnight hauled on the wind heading S & E at Daylight made sail again latter part the same Lat by Obs 16° 59' N Long by Chro 171° 14' W

Monday
June 3rd First part of this day strong wind from the E & E and cloudy middle and latter part the same at sunset took in sail as usual, and wore ship heading to the S at Daylight made sail again Lat by Obs 17° 9' N

Tuesday
June 4th First and latter part of this day strong wind and cloudy middle part rains at Dark took in sail at Daylight set the top sails Double Reefed so ends this Lat by Obs 17° 30' N

Wednesday
June 5th All these 24 hours light gales from the E & E and cloudy at Dark wore ship heading S & E by N at 8 A.M. cept off at meridian hauled on the wind so ends this day Lat by Obs 16° 55' N Long 171° 45' W

Thursday
June 6th First part of these 24 hours light gales and cloudy steering by the wind wind from the E & E at Dark took in sail at Daylight made sail

Friday
June 7th First and middle part of these 24 hours strong wind from the E & E latter part more moderate at Dark took in sail heading S & E at 3 A.M. wore ship heading S & E at Daylight made sail at Daylight at meridian saw the Island of Olatulak one of the Navigators bearing S. W. cept off for it so ends this day Lat by Obs 14° 42' N Long by Chro 176° 40' W

Saturday
June 8th First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the E & E steering in for the land at 4 P.M. the harbor on the S W side bore S & W about 3 miles dist. run down the land and lay off the S W lay several canoes came off at 7 P.M. Double Reefed the topsails and hauled her of shore at Daylight land bore S & W 7 miles dist run in and lay off and on sent 1 Boat ashore for water two for hogs and so ends this day

Sunday
June 9th all these 24 hours light breeze and fine weather laying off and on at Olatulak first part got off one raft of water 27 hogs two Boat loads of coconuts and yams at Dark cept off S at Daylight the land bore S & E at meridian land bore E so ends this day

Monday
June 10th first part of this day fresh breeze and cloudy middle part the same latter part light breeze and fine weather at Dark the land bore S & E at Daylight bore S W so ends this Lat 14° 25' N

Tuesday
June 11th These 24 hours light wind from the Eastward steering by the wind the carbon red sticks aboard the Island Olatulak bore S W at 7 A.M. Maone bore
