

Tuesday June 11th bore S E, tacked ship and stood on the wind heading to the S. so ends
Lat by Obs 13° 51' N
Long by Chron 169° 51' W

Wednesday June 12th These 24 hours light winds from the Eastward, steering by the wind with the larboard tacks on board. at 4 P.M. see whales lowered got none. came on board. the Island Maoune bearing from us E by S. at midnight tacked ship and stood in for the land. at daylight land bore S by E. steering in at 10 A.M. tacked ship. lat by Obs 14° 29' N

Thursday June 13th This day light winds and fine weather first part land bore S E. steering to the Southward, at 4 P.M. see whales lowered got 3 one to the starboard. Boat two to the Bow boat. took them along side and lay by all night, at daylight began to cut, at 11 A.M. got done land bearing S E. so ends

Friday June 14th First part of this day strong winds and cloudy, middle part squally with rain latter part strong winds first part began to boil, at 11 P.M. cooled down the works at 5 A.M. started them again so ends this day

Saturday June 15th All these 24 hours strong winds and cloudy, employed in boiling blubber at 6 P.M. cooled down. the three whales made 3000
Lat by Obs 14° 21' N

Sunday June 16th All these 24 hours strong winds from the Eastward and cloudy steering by the wind heading in for the land. at 3 P.M. tacked ship. at dark took in sail at daylight made sail again so ends

Monday June 17th These 24 hours light gales and squally with rain. at 5 P.M. furled the fore and mizen topsails so ends the 24 hours
Lat 15° 13' N

Tuesday June 18th All these 24 hours light gales and squally at daylight set the fore and mizen topsails double reeved so ends this day
Lat by Obs 15° 39' N

Wednesday June 19th These 24 hours fresh breeze from the E S E. and cloudy, steering by the wind heading to the South so ends
Lat by Obs 16° 52' N

Thursday June 20th First part of this day strong and cloudy, middle and latter part good weather. latter part employed in stowing down oil in the main hatch way so ends this day

Friday June 21th These 24 hours fresh breeze and good weather. employed in stowing down oil latter part got done. Stowed down 128 bbls so ends
Lat by Obs 17° 12' N

Saturday June 22th These 24 hours strong winds, and squally with rain at 4 P.M. shued up the fore and mizen topsails at daylight set them again double reeved so ends this day
Lat 17° 01' N

Sunday June 23th All these 24 hours strong winds and cloudy, under double reeved topsail so ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 17° 11' N
