Thurs 5th of Nov commences fine weather light
trades at daylight coaled down at
sun rise began to cut out in the whales
and began to bail at 1 P.M. saw breaches
to windward saw them till sun down
batter part calm all hands employed bailing
Long 174° 55' W Lat 1° 50' South

Fri 6th Fine weather light trades at daylight
saw whales lowered L.B. out stanch
other boats chased them could
not get past at 10 P.M. took
him alongside and cut him in
and began to bail again will
make perhaps 25 bl
Lat 2° 10' South

Sat 7th Fine weather strong trades at daylight
coaled coaled down and began to break
out in the after hold to stow down
oil stowed down 95 bl so ends this day
Lat 1° 52' S

Sund 8th Fine weather light trades all hands
employed stowing down oil in the
after hold stowed down 54 bl
Lat 1° 46' S Long 175° 09' W

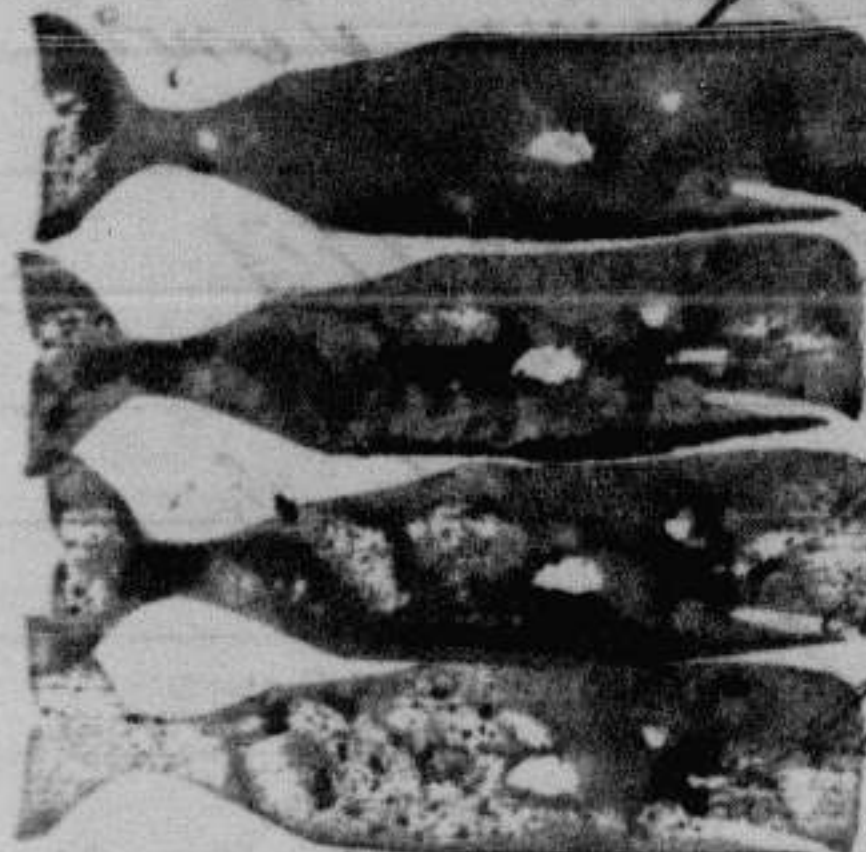
Mon 9th fine weather light trades all hands
severely engaged doing nothing
at 11 P.M. passed over a reef
apparently not more than 100
fathoms of water on it in Lat 1° 36' S
Longitude 175° 24' W Lat at Mer 1° 33' S

Tues 10th Fine weather and calm at 9 P.M. saw
whales lowered 4 boats got 2 whales
one to the S and into the L.B. boat
took them alongside and cut them in
at sund down lower again W.B. out
at one whale

Thurs 11th of Nov fine weather and calm
at 9 P.M. saw whales lowered
4 boats got 4 whales 2 school whales
to the L.B. and to the W.B. boat and
one large whale to the S.B. boat
took them alongside at 6 P.M. and
cut in 2 small ones lay by the others
Lat 1° 10' S Long



Fri 12th Fine weather and calm employed
cutting and bailing so ends this day
Lat 1° 16' South

Fri 13th Fine weather and calm all hands
employed bailing 8 bl at 9 P.M.
coaled down they all to gather made sea
Lat 1° 26' South Long 177° 22' W

Sat 14th Fine weather light trades all hands
employed doing nothing saw nothing
Lat 1° 10' South Long 176° 43' W

Sund 15th Fine weather and calm stowing down
oil in the fore hold
Lat 1° 33' S Long

Mon 16th Fine weather and calm at day
light commenced stowing down
oil at 9 A.M. saw whales
lowered 4 boats got 2 whales
to the S and to the L.B. boat
took them alongside and cut
one in lay by the other all night
Lat

Tues 17 at daylight cut in the whale
and began to bail all hands.
Lat 1° 49' S

Thurs 18th fine weather light trades all hands
employed stowing down oil in
the fore hold
Lat 1° 10' South
