

Ship given Howland Cruising around

Thurs 7th of June fine weather and calm at daylight
began to cut out in the whales
and began to boil the soups in sight
Lat $3^{\circ}20'$ South Long $117^{\circ}02'E$

Frid 8th fine weather and light trades
at 12th coiled down and washed
the decks off at sun down & sail
in sight Lat $3^{\circ}02'$ Long $117^{\circ}20'E$

Sat 9th light and baffling winds with squalls
of rain at 5 PM spoke the Courier
Lat $3^{\circ}00'$ South of N. W. of 2 mos out 1600 lbs

Sund 10th light baffling winds with squalls of
rain the Courier lowered in sight
Lat $2^{\circ}45'$ South Long $117^{\circ}35'E$

Mon 11th squally weather at 11 AM saw whales
lowered got 1 to the ship cut him
in and stood along at 3 PM
saw whales lowered again got to
the ship took him along side and
lay by him all night the Courier
in sight hailing Lat
Long

Tues 12th calm and steady rain at 8 AM cut
in the whale and began
to boil raising 1st & 2nd
all this day the Courier
in sight in the morning
No observer

Wed 13th fine weather chased whales all day
got nothing Lat $3^{\circ}00'$
Long $115^{\circ}00'E$

the Hingmills group in June 1841 in Baker's Bay

Thurs 14th of June fine weather strong trades
all hands employed doing nothing
Lat $3^{\circ}05'$ South Long

Frid 15th saw whales got none two ships in sight
Lat Long

Sat 16th fine weather light trades saw whales lowered
stuck a cow and calf cow sunk saved the
calf and yanked with the Courier
Lat $3^{\circ}03'$ South Long $117^{\circ}44'E$

Sund 17th fine weather light trades at 9 AM
saw whales lowered in company with
the Courier got nothing at 2 PM saw
whales lowered again got to the ship
got him alongside at sun down lay
by him all night 2 ships in sight
Lat $2^{\circ}44'$ South Long $117^{\circ}25'E$

Mon 18th fine weather light trades at daylight
cut in the whale and commenced
boiling two ships in sight one boiling
Lat $2^{\circ}46'$ South Long $117^{\circ}44'E$

Tues 19th fine weather light trades at 8 AM spoke
the Barque Elizabeth of London
29 mos out 1800 lbs of oil
Lat $2^{\circ}16'$ Long $117^{\circ}12'E$

Wed 20th fine weather and light trades at 4 PM
sighted the ship the Elizabeth
in sight off the Lookout
Lat $2^{\circ}38'$ South Long $116^{\circ}16'E$

Thurs 21st fine weather light trades on sail in sight
Lat $2^{\circ}41'$ South Long $116^{\circ}20'E$
