Mon 10th fine weather light trades at 2 PM spoke the London P and came north her
Lat 12° 1' South Long 169° 12' W

Tues 11th fine weather light trades at 10 AM
saw whales lowered boat got
3 whales 1 to the S & 2 to the
L boat W boat got stove
L boat even the L P off to
seaward whaling
Lat 12° 1' South Long 169° 26' W

Wed 12th fine weather light trades all hands employ
boiling blubber Lat 1° 49' South
Long 170° 31' W

Thurs 13th fine weather strong trades at 8 AM
cocks down turned up 60 lbs
Lat 5° 3' S Long 170° 41' West

Fri 14th fine and light trades saw whales and
chased them all day and got none

Sat 15th fine in light trades
Lat 8° 18' S Long 171° 08' W

Sund 16th fine and light trades
Lat 18° 1' S Long 171° 25' W

Mon 17th fine weather light trades all hands
employed breaking out and stowing
down oil in the fore hold
stowed down 93 to 12 pipes
Lat Long 171° 35' W

Ship in 1864 in Baker Master

Tues 18th of May fine weather light trades saw
nothing Lat 10° S Long 172° 10' W

Wed 19th fine weather light trades steering off to
the Westward saw a fin back
Lat 10° 42' South Long 172° 41' West

Thurs 20th fine weather light trades working off
to the westward
Lat 10° 44' S Long 173° 52' W

Fri 21st fine weather light trades steering N by S at
1 PM saw a sail ahead at sun down
light to and took in sail for the night
Lat 10° 47' S Long 174° W

Sat 22nd fine weather light trades steering
N by W at 10 AM light her W by S
at 11 AM saw a sail distant ahead saw
back in Lat 12° South Long 176° 20' W
at 12 PM saw a sail to seaward at 2 PM
an other running down at sun down the
land bearing N by W distant 6 leagues
Lat at 1 PM 13° N Long 176° 25' W

Sund 23rd fine weather light trades at 9 AM saw a sail
ahead at 9 AM saw the land and another
sail off the weather beam at 12 AM
spoke the John Coggeshall of Newport
19 May out 5 AM 600 kts whale
Lat 10° 08' N Long 176° 58' W

Mon 24th fine weather and calm saw black rock
Lat 10° 39' South Long 178° 10' W

Tues 25th fine weather light trades steering
off to the Westward the
watch employed scraping & varnishing
the Wale Lat 10° 34' S Long 179° 17' W
