Mon 29th Fine weather light trades steering to
the S & E off our lee
Lat 2° 13' S Long by Chron 172° 49' E

Tues 30th Fine weather light winds from the S & E
steering by the wind with 5 stacks onboard
Lat 3° 3' South Long 172° 42' E at

Wed 1st Dec Fine weather light trades steering
by the wind the S & E went to the S & E out
Lat 4° 1' S Long 172° 50' East

Thurs 2nd Fine weather light trades steering
to the S & E the watch employed in
Lat 1° 30' S Long 172° 45' E

Fri 3rd Clear and calm trying to work to East
Lat 1° 55' S Long 173° 14' East

Sat 4th Clear and calm so ends this day
Lat 2° 15' S Long 173° 20' E

Sund 5th Fine weather light trades steering
by the wind working to the Eastward
Lat 2° 45' S Long 173° 13' E

Mon 6th Dec 1841 Fine weather strong trades
steering to the S & E
Lat 2° 20' S Long 173° 24' East
Three year out with 2500 lbs sp oil

Tues 7th of Dec Fine weather strong trades steering by the
wind at 1 PM commenced breaking out oil
in the after hold broke out 14 pipes
and 2 sixties one of them had leaked
1/2 out cooped it and stowed it down
Lat 3° 25' S Long by Chron 173° 48' E

Wed 8th Fine weather light trades steering to the
S & E Lat 2° 20' S Long by Chron 173° 48' E

Thurs 9th First and middle part fine with
flapping flaws of wind latter part squally
Lat 1° 55' S Long 173° 55' East

Fri 10th Fine weather light wind from the S & E
steering to the S & Eastward
Lat 2° 40' S Long 174° 41' E

Sat 11th Fine weather light winds from the S & E
steering to the S & Eastward
Lat 3° 25' South Long 175° 24' East

Sund 12th Fine weather light trades working
to the Eastward
Lat 3° 42' S Long 175° 46' E

Mon 13th Fine weather strong trades steering to
the S & E at 4 PM saw breacher ahead
came up to them were whales however
was too late did not get fast
Lat 3° 00' S Long 176° 12' E

Tues 14th Fine weather strong trades steering by
the wind at 4 PM saw Hope Island
bearing East Lat 2° 25' S Long 176° 20' E
